Another eventful year has been completed and the highlights are captured in this Annual Report for the year 2017-18. The various centers have strengthened their teaching systems over the year which has greatly enhanced the sustainability of CSSAR. With the addition of two new centers, the total number of students has increased to 646 registering a growth of 90 students. A full time program manager has been appointed during the year to conduct and monitor the quarterly tests, provide feedback reports, coordinate with volunteers and supervise the centers. The

focus brought on to improve quality of the education is also paying off with the students registering better scores in the school examinations. Greater emphasis is now being laid on teachers to continuously improve the learning abilities as well as monitor the results of each student. Teachers were provided training by experts on innovative techniques, critical thinking and subject focus on mathematics and science. The centers now can boast of a very competent, dedicated and motivated team of teachers who form the backbone of CSSAR.

Adequate attention continues to be given to provide extracurricular exposure to students by way of educational tours through visits to historical and heritage sites and other modern landmarks in and around Delhi, visiting Bal Bhawan, participating in tree planting ceremonies and displaying their projects in science fairs. VISION

Vision of the organization is that every child gets proper education irrespective of social and financial background.

MISSION

Provide support to disadvantaged and poor children for their educational mainstreaming and development with special focus at girl children.

ACTIVITY

We have been teaching underprivileged children in Delhi, Gurgaon and Faridabad since April 2008 and our education program targets children studying in classes I to 10 in govt schools. Quality of education is not satisfactory in govt schools hence this program complements the gaps in school education and sustains the interest of children and their parents in formal education system. Due to this program children are regular in schools and they do not drop out. They understand subjects better and are able to handle class assignments properly. Classes are conducted in slums and villages after school hour i.e., from 2 pm to 7 pm. We conduct remedial classes for those children who live in slums/villages and study in govt schools.

- Number of children increased from 556 to 646.
- 18 children cleared 10th board exam.


SPECIAL FEATURES OF OUR EDUCATION PROGRAM DESIGN:

- Quarterly individual progress of children is monitored.
- Success Criteria: Reading, Writing and Understanding of subject matter of a class in which child studies.
- Formal qualification for teachers (minimum graduation for secondary level and SSC for primary level) and effective handling of children is a must.
- Classes are conducted in slums after school hour i.e. from 2 pm to 7 pm.
- Duration of a class is one hour.
- The student teacher ratio is limited to 15:1

- There is no mixing of classes: means each class is taught separately.
- At the time of admission a test is conducted for each child and as per her learning level she is admitted in appropriate standard irrespective of her standard in school. Our focus is on learning outcome not just only passing the examyear by year.




