VISION

Vision of the organization is that every child gets proper education irrespective of social and financial background.

MISSION

Provide support to disadvantaged and poor children for their educational mainstreaming and development with special focus at girl children.

ACTIVITY

We have been educating underprivileged children in Delhi, Gurgaon, Faridabad, Sonipat, Bihar & Mughalsarai since April 2008 and our education program targets children studying in classes 1 to 10 in Govt. schools. Quality of education is not satisfactory in Govt. schools hence this program complements the gaps in school education and sustains the interest of children and their parents in formal education system. Due to this program children are regular in schools and they do not drop out. They understand subjects better and are able to handle class assignments properly. Classes are conducted in slums and villages after school hours i.e., from 2 pm to 7 pm. We conduct remedial classes for those children who live in slums/villages and study in Govt. schools.

GLIMPSES OF CHILDREN'S ACHIEVEMENTS DURING THE YEAR 2020-21

- In total, 17 children cleared 10th board exam in 2021.
- Highest percentage is 95% and lowest percentage is 86.66% in 10th board result 2021 at our Bajghera study centre.
- In New Shyam Nagar study centre, the highest percentage is 74.20% and lowest percentage is 49.60% in 10th board result 2021.
- Average percentage of our 10th passed out children is 67.90%.
