

EDUCATION PROGRAM

Currently we have the following education programs.

1. Remedial classes for school going children (primary level):

This program targets children studying in classes I to V in govt. schools. This program complements the gaps in school education. Due to this program students are regular in schools and are able to understand different subjects better.

2. Remedial classes for school going children (secondary level):

This program targets children studying in classes VI to X in govt. schools. This program complements the gaps in school education. Due to this program students are regular in schools and are able to understand different subjects better. This program is specially designed so as to reach out to the girls in the slums/villages who are generally side-lined or neglected in the education system due to various constraints. The main aim is to break this trend and empower and equip these girls with better opportunities so that they can strengthen their future.

3. Bridge course for street children who do not go to school (primary level):

- Classes are conducted having two objectives: Admit them in school who are in 6-10 years of age.
- Overaged children who cannot be admitted in school, may take exam through NIOS

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SPECIAL FEATURES OF OUR EDUCATION PROGRAM DESIGN:

- The Teacher-Student Ratio is limited to 1:15
- The selection of teachers is done in such a manner that the teachers can respect the dignity of children and can attract & sustain the interest of children.
- Formal qualification (minimum graduation for secondary level and SSC for primary level) and effective handling of children is a must.
- Remedial classes are conducted in slums after school hour i.e. from 2pm to 7pm
- Classes are conducted from 10 am to 6 pm for the underprivileged children who do not go to school.
- Duration of each class is one hour.
- Quarterly test is conducted to assess the performance of children.
- Entry level test is conducted for each child to assess their performance.
- Quarterly meeting is held to assess the performance of teachers.
- Report cards of children especially of non-performers are discussed in the meeting and suitable measures are taken.
- School admissions of the children who do not go to school.
- Feedback from parents is obtained about children's performance

Success Criteria

- Reading, Writing and Understanding of subject matter of a class in which child studies.
- Improvement of attendance in school.

- Reduction of drop-out in school especially of girl children.
- Admission to school.
