To honor young cancer survivors pursuing higher studies

For 9 years this June, Samiksha Foundation has been doing work providing continued education and non-medical support for children undergoing cancer treatment in Kidwai Memorial Hospital. In March 2018, Samiksha launched the “Samiksha Scholarships Program” to provide financial support for young cancer survivor students. 21 scholarships were disbursed to children of 8th to 12th Grade, who have done exceptionally well in school, and wish to continue their studies.

The second series of the “Samiksha Scholarships Program”, is being sponsored by “Let’s Do Some Good Foundation” through its newly launched “Devjani Pillai Scholarship Fund.
