

- Disseminate information on preventive strategies for children and youth with Autism, Intellectually Impaired and Cerebral Palsy.
- Sensitize community stakeholders
- Publicize and maximize benefits of the PwDs and for families of PwDs.
- Increase representation in remote areas and in areas where awareness, sensitization, social integration and mainstreaming is under-represented.
- Spread awareness about myths and misconceptions about disability, disability etiquette etc.
- Educate the communities who do not approach the special education facilities due to social stigma.

- Persons with Disabilities undergo special education, dance and music therapy, sensory activities, occupational therapy, applied behavioral analysis, physiotherapy and speech therapy by trained therapists and pathologists and educators.


