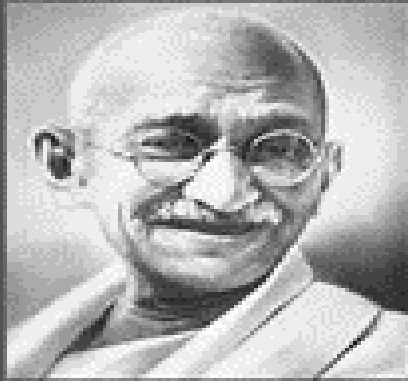

ADOPTION OF VILLAGES

We have ten villages adopted in Gujarat

HEALTH CARE

Diagnostic health check up & free medicine distribution camp.

EYE CAMPS with free distribution of eye drops & spectacles. Facilitating free cataract operation.

ENT CAMPS With check up of hearing & distribution of hearing aid machines at reasonable rate.

DENTAL CAMPS

Diabetic check up & awareness camp

EDUCATION:- AWARENESS CAMPS

WOMEN HEALTH AWARENESS CAMPS. Educate the villagers on prevention of sickness and on cleanliness. Promotion of menstrual hygiene by educating women in the village on using hygiene products like sanitary napkins.

We provide free sanitary napkins and iron tablets to the village women.

ADOLESCENCE PROGRAM

As a part of our awareness we have started new sports activities at Villages Ghoda and Jalampura District Viramgam. The Idea behind this is to develop skills of student and prevent them from cultivating unhealthy habits and with a view to divert the minds of the adolescents from unhealthy and unproductive activities & creating aspiration to do good in life.

ECONOMIC–LIVELIHOOD

TO CREATE OPPORTUNITIES IN THE VILLAGES FOR THE YOUTH & WOMEN:

Encouragement is given to the farmers as well as women to have small business activities to supplement their income. This will reduce the village youths from migrating to and nearby towns for higher education and employment.

SWATCHTA ABHYAN

Free distribution of dustbins, brooms , bamboo brooms, garbage bags to Gram Panchayats to keep village clean.

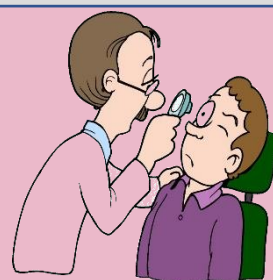

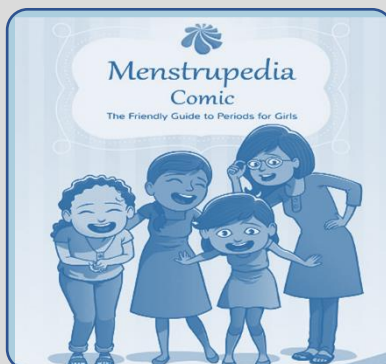

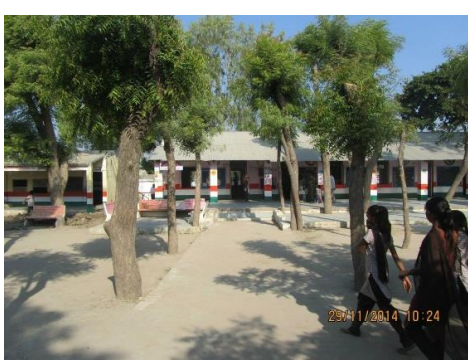

DATE	VILLAGE	PROJECTS
20 June	Nani Kaloli district kheda	EYE CHECK UP. Total 140 villager attended camp out of this 72 male and 68 females. 26 senior citizens also benefited, of who 10 males and 16 female. Free consultation as well as medicines & spectacles were provided. Twelve diagnosed having cataract. Arrangement for free cataract operation has been made.
28 June	Rudatal dist. Detroj jilla	FREE EYE CHECK-UP CAMP Total registration 211. 96 males and 115 females. & senior citizens 79 of which 32 male & 47 females.18 patients diagnosed having cataract. Arrangements for free cataract operation were made at the nearest hospital, Free consultation as well as medicine 167 spectacles was provided.
14 July	Asjol dist. Becharaji jilla	DIAGNOSTIC HEALTH CHECK UP & FREE MEDICINE DISTRIBUTION CAMP Total registration of only 70 villagers. This includes 34 males and 36 females. With senior citizen 21(12 male & 9female.) Free consultation and medicine were provided.
31 July	village Zanjarka	Our First TREE PLANTATION PROJECT “. for tree planting at the village High school, a pilot project. Variety of plants were collected from the govt. nursery in Sitapura village some ten kms away near Bhucharaji. We could collect only 75 plants as we had a small car. The school teachers & students of eight, ninth and tenth participated. The weather was also conducive for the occasion
22 Sept	village Ghoda	FREE HEALTH CHECK-UP AND FREE MEDICINE DISTRIBUTION camp in association with Global Hospital, Thalej, Ahmedabad on –Sunday. Total 105 villagers attended for check-up...of which 49 males and 56 females ...out of which 34 senior citizens (12 males and 21 females). 30 ECGs done (Male 20 & Female) 5 have been critical needed further treatment which would be given at Global Hospital.
15 OCT	JALAMPUR VILLAGE	- FREE EYE CHECK-UP AND SPECTACLES DISTRIBUTION camp. The Total population of village is 1600 out this 112 villagers attended the eye check-up camp of which male45 & female 67 that includes 39 senior citizens (male 14. female 25) 6 of them having cataract. The venue was the Anganwadi building
	VILLAGE HEBATPUR	EYE CAMP AND SPECTACLES DISTRIBUTION The total population of village is 1800 out this 166 village people attended for eye check-up of which 77 male and 89 female that includes 58 senior citizens (28 male and 30 female) 10 of them had cataract
19 OCT	Village of Mahapura VADODARA	Further to our signing the MOU with Minds Foundation -Vadodara 19-10-19 we had been to Vadodara to Minds Foundation office and to attend their program " COMMUNITY AWARENESS PROGRAM " AT VILLAGE MAHAPURA , Taluka and Dist Vadodara . The program was in the small village of Mahapura few kms away from Vadodara in the evening after sun set, in the entrance of the village Temple A short film in Gujarati relating to mental illness and treatment, was shown and later Mr Amul of Minds Foundation explained their purpose of showing the film and asked them to inform other villagers about this program.

7-JAN 2020	VILLAGE KALOLI	OUR FIRST MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS CAMP New year with new activity, -a new program ...to create awareness on mental illness After a yearlong effort at last this project has taken shape. This program a joint venture with Minds Foundation (Vadodara) A short film “ Tarang” in Gujarati on this subject was shown. Total 52 villagers (26 males and 26 female) along with 100 school students and 4 teachers attended.
12-JAN 2020	HITCON 2020 AHMEDABAD	AT HITCON 2020 A PROGRAM BY THE DOCTORS.WITH HERVA FOUNDATION AS THE RURAL HEALTH PARTNER. Many doctors who were a delegate at the conference expressed their wish to join us in our health camps at the villages. We specially thank Management Medicos the organisers of the meet, for their constant support & encouragement it has been giving us to reach out our objectives.
21-JAN 2020	village Rudatal	DIAGNOSTIC HEALTH CHECK-UP AND FREE DISTRIBUTION OF MEDICINES CAMP at Gram panchayat office. Total 106 villagers attended camp out of which 51 male and 55 female out which 48 senior citizens (male 25 and 23 female) took advantage of the camp. Free medicine was distributed to them.
26-JAN 2020	VILLAGE GHODA	SWEATER DISTRIBUTION TO STUDENTS OF GHODA VILLAGE SCHOOL ON REPUBLIC DAY 2020. We have distributed 378 sweaters to students of std 1 to 8 of primary school of Ghoda Village.
15 FEB	Village HEBATPUR	MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAM to create awareness on mental illness, with the association of Minds Foundation, Vadodara. Total 30 villagers attended (17 females and 13 males) of which 14 senior citizens (7 female & 7 male) plus 45 students of school of std 7 and 8 also participated. A video on mental health screened. During counselling we identify 5 patients who has mental health issues WOMEN HEALTH AWATENESS PROGRAM also held in the village school. Total 84 female participated including 26 students of std 7 and 8 std. of primary school. We screened comic video of Menstrupedia-“ Hello Periods”, after which interactive session took place, wherein apart other things, the disposal of the used pads were discussed. We have distributed 92 sanitary pads free of cost to the participants. We have also donated two comic books on menstrual management –“Hello periods” to school library
25-FEB	Village VARSANG	EYE CAMP & DISTRIBUTION OF SPECTACLES free Eye check-up and spectacles distribution camp at village at panchayat office. Total population of village is 2100 out of this 130 villagers attended the eye check-up camp of which 45 male and 85 female that includes 33 senior citizens (12 male and 21 female). 7 of them has cataract advice for surgery.

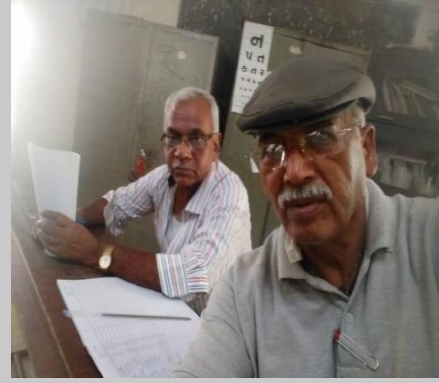

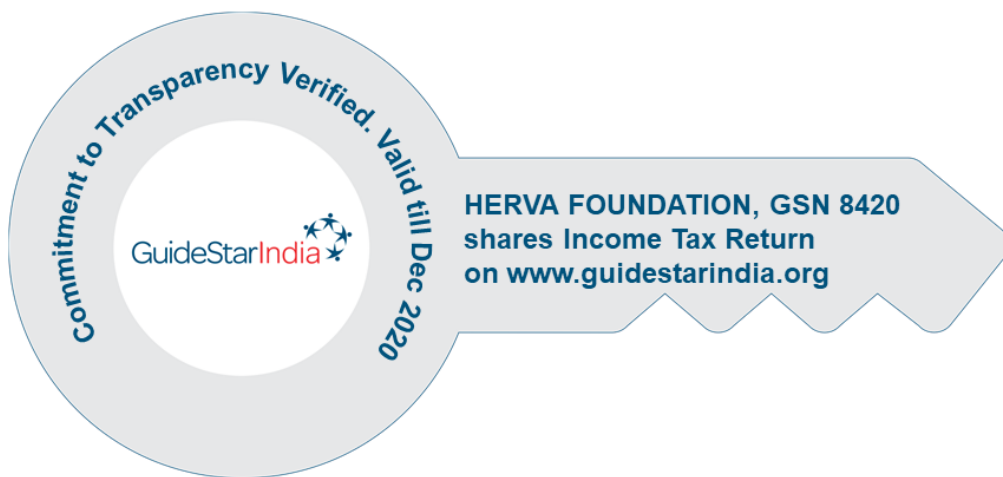
