



Shakilabi Bal Sab, a forty year old woman from Arenduru village proved that woman can also do business. Shakilabi is a member of Ishwara Self Help Group, Arenduru promoted by MANUVIKASA on 02-06-2014. Her husband Bal Sab has also engaged himself in fish selling. She has three children, a daughter and two sons.

In earlier days Shakila helps her husband in fish selling. As she got trained of this business she was decided to start this by own. Initially she was invested about Rs. 5000 by taking loan from the SHG. But with this small capital she didn't purchase or sell much. Her income was not as much she wanted. She was intended to expand her business and asked loan in banks. But she was not able to get loan from any bank without collateral. Her husband suggested applying for loan in MANUVIKASA. On 07/02/2016 she was taken Rs. 30000 loan from Micrograam through MANUVIKASA. With this loan she was purchased fish in bulk quantity. Now, every day she sells about 40-50 Kg fish and earns Rs. 4000.

Her savings per month is about Rs. 6000 (Rs. 200 per day). Her economical condition also changed due to her this. Thus Shakilabi proved herself as a business woman.
