MANUVIKASA develops 32 big lakes

Kantraji Lake of Sirsi taluk



MANUVIKASA has developed 32 big lakes in Sirsi and Mundagod Taluks of Uttara Kannada District, Sorab Taluk of Shivamogga District and Hanagal Taluk of Haveri District.

MANUVIKASA, an organization established in Siddapur Taluk of Uttara Kannada District is working in more than 800 villages of three districts on water conservation, biodiversity conservation and women empowerment.

The organization started constructing small tanks and farm ponds in 2012 with the partnership of farmers. Since then Deshpande Foundation is helping in constructing these water harvesting structures by taking half of the total cost as contribution from the farmers. The organization is able to construct 3000 small tanks by gradually increasing contribution from the farmers. MANUVIKASA staff members identify the suitable place for farm pond construction.

MANUVIKASA's farm pond programme has converted fallow lands into agricultural lands.

Coca Cola Foundation, after observing MANUVIKASA's water conservation programme helped in developing 10 big lakes in Banavasi and Sorab Hobli last year.

The organization partially completed work of 7 lakes in the previous year and now completed the work of remaining lakes. Farmers from Narur and Tigani village are co-operated completely by drying up the tank for developmental work. When the organization decided to continue lake work in Narur, Hadalagi-Madhuravalli, Gudnapur and Kantraji, farmers came forward to transport silt to their agricultural fields and supported lake development programme.

Farmers of Mundagod, Sirsi and Hanagal saw lake development work in Banavasi and Sorab Hobli and requested the organization for the development of lake in their village stating that they transport silt in their own cost. The organization has come forward for the rejuvenation of 22 lakes with the financial support from HDB Financial Service Ltd. Already developmental work of 21 lakes is completed and one lakes' work is under progress.

INR to strengthen the activities of the organization. Now the organization has come forward to develop farm ponds, water conservative units in Betta lands and de-siltation of 50 big lakes for the convenience of small and marginal farmers.

MANUVIKASA is leading a team of 30 youngsters having experience in the implementation of rural development activities. The organization is open to receive suggestions and guidance from all the corners of the society. The organization can reach more people if the government identifies and encourages us.

Hosur lake of Sorab taluk rejuvenated by Manuvikasa











"Nobody else has de-silted this lake to such an extent after Kadamba Dynasty", are the admirable words from the elders of Hosur village of Sorab taluk. Development of these 10 lakes has facilitated more than 900 farmer families and 3000 acres of farming fields. MANUVIKASA has spent 1.30 crore INR in de siltation of lake and farmers have spent 1.50 crore INR to transport the silt to their farming land.

Young farmer Parashuram from Hosur and senior farmer Shankar Goudru from Kantraji expressed their view about putting silt to their farming land as they have got more yield this year in paddy which is a result of putting silt.

Big bund is constructed beside Gudnapur lake and way for tractor and tiller is made easy. Government has a proposal to convert this as a tourism spot for which bund construction has become boon.





This year de siltation work has been taken in Narur, Kantraji, Gudnapur and Hadalagi. Farmers in Narur have transported silt through more than 15 tractors every day for more than one month. Every day one tractor can transport 20 loads of silt on an average.

MANUVIKASA has rejuvenated 22 new lakes this year with the help of HDB Financial Services Ltd.

HDB Financial Services Ltd had given grant to develop only 20 lakes; But MANUVIKASA has developed two more lakes by using the budget allotted for salary of Director.

Many village leaders and elected members are forcing to develop their lake over a phone call. But most of them get disconnected with the organization after lake rejuvenation. But very few people will be having continuous contact with the organization and started fishery, growing plants on the bund etc. income generation activities. They work like bridge between the villagers and organisation to provide the benefits of our other activities to the villages.

Locals of Hallikoppa village forced the organization to develop their 9 acre lake through Mr. Dheeraj Hulekal. But it became difficult to the organization to develop such a big lake. Then local people contacted the organization through Grama Panchayath member Mr. Sudheer Gaitonde and requested to develop as much as possible. Then the organization started rejuvenating the lake. Despite having very less households in the village, villagers hired more and more number of tractors and transported most of the silt. This act of villagers helped the organization to de silt more area of the lake than estimated. It became a very memorable moment for the organization as villagers of Hallikoppa felicitated Mr. Ganapati Bhat, the head of the organization and Mr. Ashwath Naik, organizational staff.

MANUVIKASA is not getting grant from any donors to transport the silt. Without people participation the organization is not doing any work. If the farmers and the villagers are ready to pay half of the total cost, then only MANUVIKASA sends proposals to the donor agencies and comes forward to do that particular work.

The organization has developed 3000 farm ponds and small tanks, more than 10000 water harvesting pits and more than 200 big water harvesting structures in Betta Land so far. Along with this, has rejuvenated 32 big lakes with the participation of the farmers. Farmer participation is not one day procedure. The organization has doing adventure from so many years to convert mentality of people from everything should be done by the government freely to its' our duty to have partnership in the development. It has become possible because Board of Trustees are guiding Managing Trustee and MANUVIKASA staff without giving much emphasis on awards and media publicity.

MANUVIKASA has developed tanks in Mundagod, Sirsi, Sorab and Hanagal Taluks. Local public representatives have done supportive efforts to help our staff for delivering MANUVIKASA activities to the door steps of the community. Locals have solved the problems of lake encroachment themselves. The organization whole heartedly acknowledges the help of all these people.
