My areas of responsibility are in train the caregivers in auriculotherapy, to school in psychiatrically focus areas as a psychiatric nurse, treatments in auriculotherapy for stationary and outpatient, gathering of stats in NADA Ear-Acupuncture.

The local students (caregivers) are very interested and curious to learn this treatment modality.

The patients feel sometimes afraid from the needles. After a few treatments the feedbacks are positive and they report are, that NADA acupuncture has had positive effects on detoxification. They are more calm, sleeping better and the withdrawal symptoms are more tolerable.
