1. Change of Trustees:

In the Journey of contributing to the Society through Watershed development programs, Education on environment, Human rights, Cattle and human health, promotion of Self-help Groups, Skill building to youths and Personality development of school children by Sree Jnanodaya Grameena Vidya Trust, has brought change in the Board of Trustees to enhance the Trust's capabilities. Trust deed was amended on 06.06.2013 at Sub registrar Office, Mulbagal, Kolar district, Karnataka.

2. ACTIVITIES 2013-14

(i). SREE JNANODAYA TRUST since its inception in 1993, for past 20 years managed to contribute through variety of interventions in the rural development space. Road Safety, Watershed development programs, Education on environment, human rights, Cattle and human health, promotion of Self-help Groups, Skill building to youths and Personality development to school children with the support from various Donors, well-wishers, Government and Banks.

(ii). during the year Sree Jnanodaya Trust signed Contract Agreement with M/s. The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI), Southern Regional Centre, Bangalore between 01.07.2013 and 31.03.2016 (30 months) to provide assistance in the Monitoring, Evaluation, Learning and Documentation for Integrated Watershed Management Project of 7 districts in Belgaum, Bijapur, Bagalkote, Dharwad, Haveri, Gadag and Uttara Kannada of Karnataka state.

In the above project Trust was engaged in;

1. Deputation of 8 staff
2. Regular facilitation, field coordination, guidance to field staff
3. Collate monthly watershed visit plan by staff
4. Facilitate and provide inputs (Information, data collection, photos etc.) for reporting as per requirement of the project
5. Review all reports and case studies submitted by field staff
6. Coordinate and Conduct surveys for baseline study, impact study survey, thematic study etc.,
7. Assist in timely delivery of all outputs of the project
8. Participate in review meetings as and when required
9. Organise and mobilise field visits for TERI officials

(iii). Sree Jnanodaya has provided above services successfully during the year in the implementation of watershed activities in 1.87 lakh Ha, spread across 7 districts in Phase 1 and 2.

Our staffs were involved in collating monthly watershed wise progress including quality aspects pertaining to people institutions like Watershed Committees, User Groups, Executive Committees and Self Help Groups,

capacity building activities, awareness programs, skill building and Income Generation Activities.

One Baseline survey, one impact study and two thematic studies on Socio economic aspects of watershed as prescribed by the project from time to time was another key area where we worked during the year. We contributed field inputs to build 8 case studies on socio economic aspects in the watershed. Our team attended 34 review meetings conducted at block and district level watershed offices and 4 workshops organised by TERI. 8 visits by TERI and watershed department have been facilitated. 1,200 Family visits were made by our staff to monitor the Income Generation Activities.
