1. Plantation Drive at DTEA Sr. Sec. School, Mandir Marg, New Delhi on 05.06.2022

The school are consists of classes from 1 to 5. It's a morning shift Girls school and there are around 300 Girlsstudents and 10 teaching staffin this school.

16. Plantation Drive at Dr B.R. Ambedkar School of Specialised Excellence, Sector 6, Dwarka, New Delhi on 04.02.2023
