Nothing can beat the happiness of a smile and at ABMSS, our main focus has been on supporting underprivileged children across the country with safe, accessible and well-timed surgery for cleft malformations and other congenital facial deformities.

Dignity is an important aspect of human life and it allows a person to live his/her life to the fullest. With a life transforming cleft surgery, our help is not only limited in giving back the children their normal look but also a dignified life for whom its a dream that came true.

Apart from the surgeries, we also organise extensive cleft awareness drives schools, child care institutions and through mass media in rural areas and time after time, we have witnessed the increased awareness on clefts among people and we believe that people's perception has been changing due to this effort.

We believe that cleft is merely a treatable health condition and a simple surgery of 45 minutes can totally change the life a cleft child.

This year, we were able to finance 2660 free surgeries across 29 locations in India and 25% of these children received comprehensive care. However, 35 000 children born with cleft lip and palate in our country every year and there are cleft children who have still not received the required surgeries.

As we look back on the last financial year, we have achieved this much and but the journey has just begun. We have to go a long way to see that every child born with a cleft receives a safe and well-timed surgery and integrated well into the society.

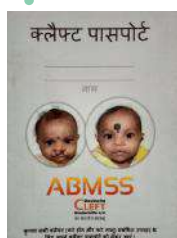


Cuddles for cleft

Naveen and Arpitha look forward to their daughter's new life

The usual joy and celebrations associated with the birth of a newborn was not there when Arpitha gave birth to a cleft baby. Everybody around them at the time of the child's birth came with myths and unwanted advice. Naveen, the child's father was too worried about his daughter and would often ask his wife, did we do any mistake?

"In our family, nobody was ever born with a cleft or even seen it elsewhere, so it was a shocking news for us. Adding to our worries and sufferings, the social pressure was also unbearable," said Naveen.

Naveen lives in Hosahalli with his family, a small village under K R Nagar taluk of Mysore district. He is a marginal farmer and his earning was barely enough to make a normal living. He knew that even if treatment may be available, he cannot afford the cost of that treatment.

However, Naveen and Arpitha did not lose hope and were always searching for help. After two months of struggle and desperation in life, their hope bloomed when they met our social worker. He informed Naveen that their child's cleft can be treated. Moreover, he also told him that his daughter could lead a totally normal life, as cleft is a defect, not a disease.

As soon as the child turned four-months old, Naveen and Arpitha brought her to St. Joseph's Hospital, our cleft centre in Mysore. Dr Manu Prasad, who runs our cleft centre, informed the parents that the child will look normal after the surgery.

Their daughter was operated in the month of November 2018 and the result was remarkable, they could not believe their eyes! When our social worker asked Arpitha about how she felt, she said " today will be a memorable day for us. It would not have been possible without the help of the hospital and those who funded our child's surgery.

We hope that our daughter becomes a doctor in future and serves the poor so that money does not become a barrier to receive quality health services" she concluded.

OUR APPROACH TO COMPREHENSIVE CLEFT CARE

Principle 1: Comprehensive Child centered cleft care

A child born with a cleft faces many hurdles and needs love and support and best of the treatment. Some clefts need little repair while other types of clefts will need many surgeries and therapies. A variation of all or some of these clefts can happen and makes each child born with a cleft unique. To give them the smile they deserve we support all dimensions of comprehensive cleft care to be defined as follows:



All types of cleft related surgeries: Lip, palate, Alveolar bone, Nose reshaping & other advanced procedures



Free Stay, transportation to and from and food at the hospital



Ear, Nose and Throat (ENT)



Speech and functional therapy



Counselling and feeding instructions



NAM, Dental & Orthodontic treatment



Distribution of vitamins and nutrition supplements

Principle 2: Quality medical treatment

It is our aim to provide excellent cleft care to the less privileged sections of society. Six arms of our high quality medical treatment are: Safety, Effectiveness, Patient centeredness, Timeliness, Efficiency and Equitability.

We are very happy that our surgeons are highly experienced experts, most of whom having performed more than 1000 cleft surgeries. In order to keep and further enhance a high level in quality, we train junior surgeons through fellowships and support state-of-the-art medical equipment.

Principle 3: Permanent centres approach

The objective of establishing permanent centres is to create sustainable local structures in close cooperation with surgeons and medical personnel. With its core experts, highly specialised surgeons, technicians, advanced equipment and resources, it drives high medical care for our little patients through their journey that lasts many years.

Principle 4: Cost effectiveness

Treatment of cleft lip and cleft palate consists of multiple surgical procedures and comprehensive cleft care therapy that begins at infancy and continues through adolescence. We work with highly motivated and experienced partners to deliver the best treatment at a very effective price.

Workshop for partner surgeons supported by Deutsche Cleft Kinderhilfe, Germany

Annual workshop for our medical team is intended to have a common platform for surgeons, anesthetists and other medical professionals where exchange of ideas and mutual learning takes place. It is also vital for them to interact and learn with the fellow surgeons and medical experts in order to improve their skills on surgical aspects and be updated to the modern technologies that are linked to cleft treatment. This year, His Excellency Mr. Jorn Rohde, the Ambassador of Federal Republic of Germany, SL, graced the event and fuelled spirit of the surgeons to be committed to the cause of cleft care. We also had Prof. Dr Yong Bae Kim from South Korea and Prof. Dr Ben JP Lai from Taiwan who delivered lectures on Overlapping IVVP & Pharyngoplasty, Primary Cheiloplasty, Congenital Nasal Dysgenesis, Alveolar Bone Grafting and Cleft Rhinoplasty.

Naso Alveolar Moulding (NAM) workshop supported by Transforming Faces, Canada

On 25th November, a workshop on Naso-Alveolar Moulding (NAM) was organised for our orthodontists and cleft surgeons in Bangalore where renowned orthodontist Dr Akshai Shetty took sessions on bio-mechanics of Alveolar and nasal moulding, non-surgical columella elongation and clinical observation of patients under treatment with NAM appliance therapy.



Capacity Building workshop on Comprehensive Cleft Care (CCC)

A capacity building workshop on comprehensive cleft care was conducted in Puspanjali Hospital, Agra on 25th to 28th October, 2018. Mr. Hugh Brewster and Ms. Courtney Mollenhauer from Transforming Faces, Canada conducted the workshop and delivered talks on various aspects of CCC and circle of cleft care for our project team members. Goa cleft mission

From 20th to 23rd March 2019, we conducted a cleft mission in Goa at Manipal Hospital to provide free cleft surgeries to children born with cleft lip and palate and congenital facial deformities in the state. Over 20 cleft patients were screened out of which 10 patients were provided with cleft surgeries during the mission. The mission was well supported by the staff and medical team of Manipal hospital. The mission was sponsored by our CSR donor Persistent Foundation.



Awareness workshop with Anganwadi workers

ABMSS organised a cleft orientation workshop for Anganwadi workers at Pernem, Goa in collaboration with Dept. of Women and Child Development, Government of Goa. More than 100 Anganwadi Workers from North Goa attended the workshop and learned basics of cleft and informed about how they can help us identifying cleft children. As a front-line health worker in village level, they were also informed about their role in helping our organization in identifying and referring cleft patients from their respective localities. The workshop was supported by our CSR donor Persistent Foundation.

In the operating theatre errors are frequent and often consequential. Enhancing operating theatre efficiency ensures patient safety and boosts the confidence of surgeons and the supporting staff. Search and awareness camps

In the year 2018-19, we have organised more than 600 cleft awareness camps and extensive patient search initiatives across 29 locations in 14 states. As you may know that Search and Awareness camps serve two main purposes. First of all, our social workers travel to the remotest parts of the country to identify cleft patients where many people are reportedly unaware about the cleft and its possibility of treatment. Without the patient search initiative, many people with a cleft might have lived their lives without treating their cleft as there is a huge communication gap between the needy and those who provide the services. Secondly, through our awareness work, many people are taught that cleft is treatable and the person will be normal after the surgery. This part is always kept clouded with the prevalent myths and as a fall out, many cleft patients cannot have a chance to treat their clefts.
