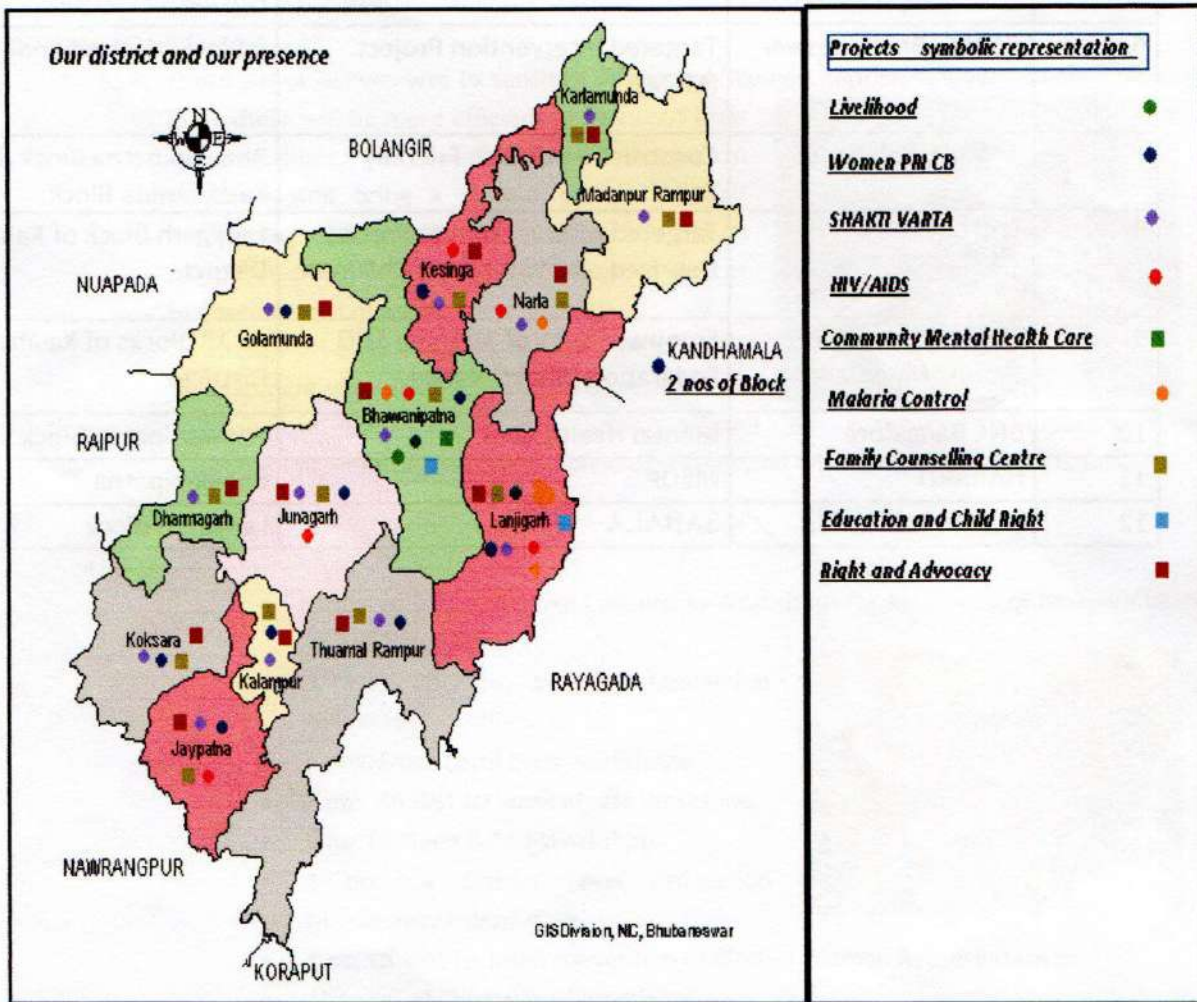

## PROJECT SASHAKTI (WOMEN EMPOWERMENT)

**Name of the Project – THE HUNGER PROJECT**

**Project Area – 7 nos. of Blocks of Kalahandi.**

### **Introduction:-**

DAFTA started working on the issue of Gender mainstreaming in local governance through leadership building of elected women representative from April, 2004 under the aegis of THE HUNGER PROJECT, New Delhi. This movement initially was started in 9 blocks through a development network LOK ADHAKAR SAMMUKHIYA KALAHANDI by 10 partner NGOs. DAFTA is the lead implementing agency of the project in 7 intensive blocks of Kalahandi District such as Bhawanipatna, Kesinga, Karlamunda, Koksora, Th.Rampur, Junagarh and Lanjigarh. Also implementing this project in two blocks of Kandhamal Dist. of Odisha.



### **Main Objectives :-**

- Our main objectives was to sensitize all elected Women Representatives of new Panchyat body those will be more efficient to carry out their responsibilities. To educated Ewrs in order to empower and bring a sustain change in their knowledge, skill, organize and practice in order to bring transparency in their ward, village as well as in development of panchyat.
- To strengthen Ewrs and their united efforts for the development of their villages as well as of panchyat to promote Ewrs those will intervene and do advocacy at different level (Government/Political) to solve problem of villages and different development issues.

### **Introduction:-**

The SANJOG FCC was started during the year 2005 with the help of Central Social Welfare Board, New Delhi and State Social Welfare Board, Bhubaneswar. This FCC focuses on misunderstanding problems, suspiciousness, unemployment, depression, love affair, extra marital affair, pre-marital problem, dowry problem etc.

### **Aims and Objectives :-**

Our FCC aims at reducing the problems and crisis, strengthening family coping skills, effecting positive changes in the attitude, improvement in lifestyle, providing timely counseling and support to lead a qualitative lifestyle.

- To create awareness about family problem, marital problem, adolescent problem, sex education etc.
- To give special education to the family members with support and extra care to the client
- To encourage the family to listen supportively to the person
- To get emotional support for the family which helps greatly in facing problem
- To discuss the family problem with the client very carefully and react fully with the family
- To encourage the role responsibility and need to normalize the activities of the individual and the client
- To educate both client and family members as how to handle their family problems

### **Cases During The Year:-**

During this year the FCC dealt 95 cases related to marital maladjustment with spouse and in-laws, dowry demands, alcoholism, extra marital affairs, exploitation by neighbour etc. Till now there is 17 cases closed during this year with mutual understanding through home visit and proper counseling.

In 2014-15, there were 88 new cases registered. Till now there 17 cases got closed with mutual understanding through home visit and proper counseling.



## SABALA

### *Name of the project – "SABALA"*

The scheme launched by Govt. of India for empowerment of group of 11 to 19. It comprised of 4 days training including one day exposure visit to existing public services. In one batch of training there is provision of 40 participants from the KISHORI SAMIDHA.

**Project Area-** All 22 nos. of Grampanchayat of Lanjigarh block of Kalahandi District covered by "DAPTA" to conduct "SABALA" training.

### *Action under Taken:-*

During this year 10 nos. of trainings conducted at Bhabangpadar, Kankubra, Bandhpuri, Lanjigarh, Gundri, Komarda, Gobaridhanpur, Batelima, Champadinpur G.Ps respectively. 400 adolescent girls were trained. The duration of the training is of 4 days include one day exposure to different places like railway station, hospital, bank, police station and post office.

### *Outcome :-*

- Now they are able to open an account, book a reservation, admit a patient, and lodge complaint at police station.
- Increased their confidence level.
- Gain Knowledge about nutrition, health, hygiene, adolescent reproductive sexual health (ARSH) and family and child care.
- Upgrade their home based skills, life skills etc.



## PROJECT SHAKTI VARTA

**Project-** SHAKTI VARTA

**Project Area -** All 13 blocks of Kalahandi District



The Project SHAKTI VARTA is a noble project which is meant for capacity building of Mission Shakti SHG members in order to bring change on water and sanitation, reducing infant mortality, reducing mother mortality and other health hazards through Participatory Learning and Action. The first phase of project started from 1<sup>st</sup> June, 2014 and completed on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2015. In this project DAPTA has appointed 39 nos. of staffs in 13 blocks of Kalahandi District those worked with WCD Department in a collaboration process. In this 10 month DAPTA has studied in the field and planned how to implement this sensitization programme in the village level. The project is meant to strengthen 7000 SHG Members those are formed by Mission Shakti. It is a collaborative project with the support of WCD Department Govt. of Odisha. In the first phase of activities DAPTA has completed mapping of SHG and selection of G.P Facilitator.

### Co-operative promotion and management

During the year DAPTA has managed two no vegetable producer co-operative Regd. under co-op. Act. 1962, Govt. of Odisha. This producer co-op name was Mahalaxmi Pariba Utpadanakari Samabaya Samiti Ltd. Balarampur and Maa Manikeswari Pariba Utpadanakari Samabaya Samiti Ltd Dumal. Total member SOS of both the co-operative. Out of that 12no of member's is enrollment and share holder, 210ac of land cover under vegetable cultivation through organic vegetable cultivation.



Our two co-operative members are produce 18010 quintal of vegetable. Both the co-operative had supported the member for organic manure and pesticide preparation kit to 20 no of land less family for organic manure and pesticide preparation and sale to growers of co-operative. The co-operative supported water lifting pump to 53no of VG and cover 32ac of land and save the crop.

### Training.

During the year DAPTA has organized 6no of training at field level for the capacity building of the co-operative members on co-operative management, organic manure and pesticide preparation, field level training to SHG and Co-operative members on various social security schemes and entitlement.

### Exposure visit

On behalf of our cooperative 4 nos of members and 2 nos of staffs had gone to Nandanabana on exposure which is a big vegetable farm of the Chattisgarh. They saw the large scale of different type of vegetable cultivation in the farm. Also they learned water management, manure



management, pest management, weed control etc. After that they had gone to visit vegetable market (Mandi) of Raipur and discussed with the farmers and process. During the year, exposure visit to our co-operative office and field from Shamati NGO from Nepal had taken place and Mr. Felix, Director of AWO International Germany had visited DAPTA also.

#### Soil testing

During the year DAPTA has done soil test 135 no of the farmer field for know the soil status about acidity and soil treatment and land cover 102 ac of land. Our PRP was done soil test and CRP was help the soil test process.

#### Crop Planning

During the year DAPTA has done 130 no session wise crop plan done by our CRP and PRP for our vegetable growers. The crop plan was much more help for the crop grown in the plan. The growers was plan about the crop like required material, land preparation, seeds collection seeds treatment, manure preparation and collection, and other required material also vegetable procure and sale and income and vegetable sale plan.

#### Hand holding support to vegetable growers

During the year DAPTA has provided hand support to 362no of vegetable growers through CRP and PRP. CRP and PRP was visit to vegetable field, see the crop and suggest to the growers like pest control, use of organic manure, water management, weed control etc and also vegetable gardening, storage and marketing and follow-up the crop plan by the growers.



#### Organic manure and pesticide preparation and sale.

DAPTA has promoted the organic vegetable cultivation through out the year through the co-operative members in the vegetable field. Our co-operative 20 no our land less members is prepare



510 liters handkhata and sale @RS.10/- pear liters through co-operative.

#### Seed Bank promotion

DAPTA was promoted 2 no of seed bank through the co-operative level. The seeds bank was collect local seeds from the vegetable growers. During the year our 216kg seeds collect and sale to our vegetable members know the growers were avil the seeds in the seeds bank in the marginal price.

#### Saving & Credit

DAPTA was promoted saving and credit through our two co-operative. During the year total Rs.1,09,700/- DAPTA was promote for regular saving through the co-operative by the 271/- members. The co-operative member are regularly saving monthly basics and vegetable cultivation for loan

support to 85no of vegetable growers Rs.5,66,000/-in the year. Before the co-operative the member are go to the money lenders in the line period quite know members are goes to the co-operative and solve the problem.

#### Convergence with line department



During the year DAPTA has convergence made 4nos of deep bore well through Biju Krushak Yojana of Govt. of Odisha. One district level Krushak Mela organized by Krushi Vigyan Kendra Bhawanipatna supported for organizing the mela at Balarampur village and two nos. of MEDP training for SHG members support by the NABARD . These training programmes 60nos of vegetable growers are



trained on vegetable cultivation. This training for resources person from Horticulture department Bhawanipatna and Krushi Vigyan Kendra Bhawanipatna, Kalahandi. DAPTA has provided 5 liter hand sprayer to 100 nos of vegetable growers for drudgery reduction.

#### Enrollment and enhancement of social security schemes

DAPTA has enhanced enrollment in govt. school by campaigning in villages social security schemes for organized training, awareness program, and lift late distribution and poster camping Like New khalti card, Old age pension, IAY, Widow pension, Handicapped person, Madhubabu pension, Mukutla, Pradhanmantri Janadhan Jozara etc. During the year 250 A/C opened in the bank and also DAPTA has work for right of women and security.



#### Awareness for male members on gender based and minimized.

During the year DAPTA has organized 4 no awareness programmer for male members on minimized the gender based discrimination 385 male members are trained on gender based practice and



minimized. DAPTA has always worked for equality and women right.

**SRI paddy promotion**

During the year DAPTA has promoted 42 ac of land of 77 nos of farmers. The farmers are follow-up SRI process. Total paddy production is 891 quintal. Our CRP and PRP were handholding support and guidance to the farmers. Use of the organic manure, pesticide also uses Mandou wider for the weed



control. DAPTA has supported 30 no of mandou weedler to the farmer.

**Organic vegetable promotion**

DAPTA has promoted 86 no of farmers 46 of land cover in vegetable cultivation through way of way organic cultivation. CRP and PRP have technical support, like Nursery raising, pest control, use of organic manure, weed control, etc. The vegetable growers are produce 3650 quintal in year. DAPTA has supported 100 no of hand hoe to 100 no of vegetable growers.



#### Co-operative promotion and registration

During the year DAPTA has started process for producer Co-operative registration procedure. We have target to cover 300 no of vegetable growers are members in the co-operative. Due to fund problem we can not registered the society Act. 1962 of govt. of Odisha.

#### Producer group promotion

DAPTA had formation 32 nos. of producer group. We cover 320 no of members in the producer group. The producer group was monthly meeting conduct ones a month our CRP has maintain the record of producer group and discussion about the crop and crop problem in the meeting. DAPTA supported to 5 no weight measure massing to 5 no of producer group.

#### Drudgery reduction

DAPTA has link for 5no of SHG for drudgery reduction. The SHG has got Rs. 50,000/- each group Rs.10,000/- from CDPO office.



#### SHG promotion and strengthening

DAPTA has promoted 22 nos. of SHG and strengthening. We have supported for record keeping, regular meeting arrange per SHG per month Rs.40/- support our CRP. The CRP has taken the



responsibility. SHG are regular saving, bank linkages, repayment to bank etc.

#### Training and exposures Visit.

During the year DAPTA has organized 15nos of field level training and conduct 2nos of community leader exposure visit for the capacity development of our women farmer on soil test and soil health management, way of organic vegetable cultivation, SRI, seeds treatment and preservation. This



training programme were conduct by the CRP and PRP.

During the year DAPTA has mobilized 8no deep bore well convergence in the field level on Biju Krusak Jajana at Dangariguda, Tikrapada and Tentulipadar village. The farmers are support 20% of the total budget.

DAPTA has been working for women on social security schemes. Women are more conscious about the social security and enhancement of livelihood.

#### Wall painting

DAPTA has done 5 no of wall painting in the project area. The wall painting has developed more clarity about the project information and activity of the project activities as well as project progress,

#### PROJECT SWASTHYA (PREVENTIVE, CURATIVE & PROMOTIVE HEALTH CARE)

**Name of the project-** HALT & REVERSE HIV/AIDS WITH TRANSGENDER COMMUNITY  
**Supported By-** OSACS, Bhubaneswar  
**Project Area-** Bhawanipatna, Jaipatna and Lanjigarh Block of Kalahandi District.

#### **Goal:-**

The goal of NACP-IV is to Halt and reverse the epidemic HIV/AIDS in India over the next five year programme.

### *Objective:-*

- Prevent infection through Saturation of Coverage of High risk group with targeted intervention Scaled up Intervention in the general population.
- Provide greater care, Support & Treatment to larger number of PLHA.
- Strengthen the infrastructure, systems & human resources in prevention, care & support programmes at district, state and National levels.
- Halt & reverse HIV/AIDS with Transgender.

### **HALT & REVERSE HIV/AIDS WITH TRANSGENDER:-**

In this project DAPTA is working in the block of Bhawanipatna , Lanjigarh& Jaipatna with 300 nos. of Transgender to whom we are providing regular awareness, treatment, care and support as follows:-

#### **• TARGETED INTERVENTION PROJECT FOR MSM (HIV/AIDS)**

#### **MAJOR ACTIVITIES**

##### **➤ HOTSPOT LEVEL MEETING:**

As we know that the T.I project focus the Targeted MSM peoples, they should have TG behavior and comes under the High Risk Group. Among this people we used to conduct a meeting at each Hotspot in every month. This meeting is known as Hotspot level meeting. Here we mainly focus to motivate them for blood testing, Condom promotion for safe sex, and HIV/AIDS awareness activities. During the year we did 60nos. of hotspot level meeting by the help of Peer Educator and hotspot committee member, where near about 900 HRGs participated cumulatively.



##### **➤ DIC LEVEL MEETING:**

DIC (Drop in centre) is a best place for HRGs to get Psychosocial Support, STI Counseling, STI Treatment, and Behavior Change Communication (BCC). This is the only place where HRGs could refer to Several Govt. Facility like ICTC Testing, STI Clinic, and ART Centre, DOT Centre etc. for the Proper Management of DIC and also for the HRGs. We had conducted two DIC level meeting on each month. In this financial year we did 24nos. of DIC level meeting, by the help of Peer Educator and Out Reach worker where near about 300 HRGs participated cumulatively.



##### **➤ ADVOCACY CUM STAKE HOLDER LEVEL MEETING:**

We had conducted an Advocacy cum stake holder level meeting with the HRGS and Government Officials held at Town Hall, Bhawanipatna where 50 nos. of HRGS participated. The aim of this meeting is to sensitize the HRGS and Govt. officials about our work and also their responsibility for the MSM people. To build better co-ordination for smooth functioning of the project.





### ➤ 27<sup>th</sup> WORLD AIDS DAY:

We celebrate World AIDS Day (1<sup>st</sup> Dec.2014) for preventing the deadly disease of HIV/AIDS from our state.

The day was organized by DAPTA with the collaboration of ZSS (Zilla Swasthya Samiti) Kalahandi at town hall, Bhawanipatna, with the presence of, Dr. Mona Majhi ,ADMO PH (DHH Kalahandi), Dr. B.K Bramha, CDMO, Kalahandi, Dr. Bibekakonda Mishra, in charge of ICTC, Bhawanipatna,



Lingsraj Ratha (PD, DRDA), Kalahandi. Apart from them the NCC Cadet, ASHAs AWWs, NGO staffs and reporters were present there. The theme of this day was **Getting to Zero**. The discussion was on Zero Aids Related death, Zero new infection, Zero stigma & discrimination, awareness, prevention, control, support, treatment and right of the vulnerable people on HIV/AIDS and duty and responsibility of the community people for the betterment of the vulnerable. In this occasion Mr. Manish purohit, PM TI project gave brief knowledge about HIV/AIDS and TI Project.

### ➤ NABARANGA MILAN (EVENT):

On 22<sup>nd</sup> march 2015 TI project DAPTA and Project Pehchan (Supported by: OSACS, Bhubaneswar and SAATHII, Bhubaneswar) organized a event named **Nabaranga Milan** for creating awareness among HRGs, Govt. official and Social science student of Govt. Autonomous collage at Town hall, Bhawanipatna. in this event Dr. B.K Bramha, CDMO, Kalahandi, invited as chief guest, DSWO, Kalahandi, DUSA, Secretary, Mr. Bharat Bhusan Panda as a guest and all the staff of DAPTA are also participate in the meeting.



As per the agenda event was inaugurated by Dr. B.K Bramha, CDMO Kalahandi by lighting of candle. After that Mr. Raju Sharma, Secretary DAPTA gave welcome speech to all the guest and participants and gave brief introduction on DAPTA. After that a welcome song sang by Mr. Somerandra Prasad Naik (ORW TI Project DAPTA). After that Mr. Sharma requested Mr. Manish Purohit (Project Manager, TI Project DAPTA) to brief about TI Project and MSM.



### ➤ HEALTH CAMP& IEC CAMPAIGN:

We Organized 3 nos. of Health camp in two blocks of Kalahandi district like – Bhawanipatna, & Jaipatna. And also gave them treatment for general diseases and identify the new STI patients who do not come to the clinic for STI treatment among the MSM group.

### ➤ STI CARE:

We have two Private Preferred Providers Dr. Purnachandra Panda M.O.AUVUSH, DHH, Kalahandi and Dr. Laxmidhar Sahoo MBBS, Govt. hospital, Bhawanipatna were providing STI treatment to the HRGs in three blocks like Bhawanipatna, Lanjigarh & Jaipatna respectively. There are three types of treatment given in the clinic Asymptomatic, Symptomatic and Regular Medical Check-up. For that we pay the doctors Rs.75/- per HRG. In this year we give 33 Asymptomatic & Symptomatic treatment and 532 Regular



#### Medical Check-up

We have counseled 300 nos. of HRGs. Among them 262 nos. of HRGs motivated to HIV test in ICTC, DHH, Bhowanipetra. Among the 262 HRGs 0 of them are found HIV positive.

#### ➤ CONDOM PROMOTION:

We motivated HRGs to use condom for safe sex, for that we established 13 nos. of condom outlets near the hotspot areas, where they can easily assess the condom for their use. In this year we have distributed 65000 pcs. Condoms through Peer Educators, Out Reach Worker, Counselor, Health camps, STI clinic and condom outlets in free of cost.

#### ➤ CBO and SHG FORMATION:

We have formed one of CBO among the HRGs under society Registration act 1860 for their self-reliant and to give them a new identity in this society namely: SANJOG through the CBO we would work for their rights & dignity. By the help of CBOs we spread the HIV/AIDS messages in the community and give them care & Support to the PLHA.

#### Introduction:-

Project PERCHIAN is CBO based project named BHAWANIS which is working for the rights of Transgender in Kalahandi district of Odisha since 1<sup>st</sup> July 2012 with the support of Solidarity Action against the HIV/AIDS (SAATHI), Kolkata and run by DAPTA, Kalahandi. The main objective of this project is to empower the Transgender in their health and rights.

#### Goal of the Project:-

To aware and improve sexual health standard of MTH population and support them to lead life with dignity among 2100 MTH people of 4 blocks of Kalahandi district, Odisha with in 2015.



#### Objective of the Project:-

- To provide sexual health information and sexual health service to MTH community till 2014.

- To develop the support group and improve the inner qualities of MTH community of Kalahandi district till 2015.
- To provide all facilities given by the Government to MTH community and mainstreaming them in society till 2016.

**Project working area:-**

The operational area is all 13 blocks of Kalahandi district, but in first stage we have taken five blocks namely 1. Bhawanipatna, 2. Kesinga, 3. Lanjigarh and 4. Junagarh 4. Dharamgarh Block of Kalahandi district, Odisha.

#### Advocacy and Meeting of Project Pehchan:-

We had organized Advocacy and Meeting in our project with various stakeholder such as Health Dept, MTH community, District legal aids Aid service (DLSA), ICTCs, Media and various line department. The main objective of Advocacy and Meeting was to sensitize the various transgender issues and try to make them involved in MTH strengthening process.

- Stakeholder Sensitization Meeting :-** Project pehchan had organised 10 nos of stakeholder sensitization with health dept. and ICTCs of Kalahandi during the period 2014-15 . In which 40 nos of participants sensitize on HIV/AIDS issue and Transgender health in odisha .
- District Legal Aids Services Agency (DLSA):-** Project pehchan organise as drive on right issue with the DLSA on Suprim Court view on NLSA judgement . Where we conducted 17 nos of Hotspot meeting in which we have a open discussion with MTH community regarding the NLSA judgement and their legal problem .
- 207 against 377 :-** We organise a discussion on 207 against 377 on dt 25/10/2014 in which 30 participants were participated and get sensitize about the NLSA judgement .
- Worlds AIDS DAY, 2014 :-** We had organized world aids day with the collaboration of Dist. Head Quarter Hospital, Bhubanipatna on date 1<sup>st</sup> December 2014 at Town Hall, Bhubanipatna. In this programme mass rally, Quiz competition, near about 110 (MTH) MSM, TG and HURA were participated. In this day MTH community of PEHCHAN organize a community DRAMA at town hall.
- Solidarity event (Nabaranga Milan -2015):-** Project Pehchan Organise a community event named as Nabarang milan -2015 . In which all MTH population of kalahandi as well as other part of odisha take part in the nabaranga Milan . In this event around 130 community member were take part in the programme. Event was ended with fully joy of the dance, drama and cultural programme.



### **Annual General Body Meeting (AGM):-**

The CEO BHAWANIS had organized Annual General Body meeting on dated 31<sup>st</sup> November, 2014 at DAPTA office premises. In this meeting 20 nos. of members were participated and elected their General body members.

### **COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH CARE**

Mental health is a big problem in Kelehandi. On an average 28000 people are suffering from mental illness. Most of them are belongs to poor family. Neither the communities are sensitized on this issue nor family person are taking proper care of the person suffering from the illness. As Kalahandi has no DMHP, people are suffering a lot to purchase medicine which is lot expensive. Looking to the matter DAPTA started community Mental Health Care project with the support of Basic Need India and operating in 10 GP of Bhawanipatna block in a low scale. DAPTA has following activities to control mental illness and it is putting pressure on Govt. to provide psychiatrist and medicine through DMHP.



- Baseline survey in pilot GP (Ringsan GP)
- 63 nos. of new PWMI identification
- FSG group create in pilot GP (Ringsan GP)
- FSG meeting for strengthening the capacity of the PWMI in every month
- Volunteer appointed in 10 GP
- Mass awareness meeting 15 nos. in 2014 (293 participant)
- 2 health camp organized in 2014 and 2015
- Skill development training for volunteer in 2015 at Sengur
- Skill development training for project coordinator and field work at Jatni in 2015
- Disability certificate issue for 30 nos of PWMI

- Livelihood support given to 4 nos. of stable PWMI
- Follow up visit to the PWMI by staff 85 nos. and volunteer 64 nos.
- World Mental Health day October 2014-2015
- We brought two severe mental patient to hospital for treatment in every critical condition
- Staff review meeting in every month
- Mass awareness meeting 13nos. in 2015 (180 participants)
- We met CDMO sir quick start of DMHP (Kalahandi)

**PROJECT SURAKSHIYA (CHILD SURVIVAL, EDUCATION, CHILD RIGHT & TRAFFICKING)**

This year was more important in which we have covered all 13 blocks of the district to check infant and child mortality. Like earlier years we had the follow up activities of breast feeding programme and this year we have selected 2 nos. of GP facilitators in 272 GP of Kalahandi Dist. total no of 544 nos. of GP facilitators those will be trained on participatory learning and action process and they will sensitize all women member of SHG how to check infant and child mortality in the district under project Shakti Varta.



Besides, that we have formed 20 nos. of childrens committee in 20 nos. of village in order to sensitize children on right to education, children right and ecology. Also the last part of this year DAPTA has included another programme destination unknown campaign for the children those are abandoned in nature and prey of human trafficking. Though this is a network programme DAPTA has agreed to implement this programme for Kalahandi District.



Though Govt. of India has closed down the NCLP schools, we could facilitate to admit 50 nos. of NCLP pass out children in tribal boarding schools after class 5<sup>th</sup>. This year we had organized 6 nos. of enrollment campaign in villages and which caused 85 nos. of children admitted in different school. After our sensitization, now 10 nos. SHG members are managing MDM in their village while they are monitoring the food distribution of AWW.



- In order to protect infant and children, DAPTA is working on popularization of breast feeding and monitoring earlier training and activities on breast feeding.
- Working on malaria and diarrhea control to protect infant and children mortality.
- Referred 22 nos. of red zone children to NRC for treatment.
- DAPTA has formed 20 nos of children and youth group in 20 villages and has trained them on child right, education and ecology.
- DAPTA has provided training to 12 nos of school management committee for better facilitation of school management.
- DAPTA has trained to 12 nos of SMC and villagers on RTE.
- As DAPTA is the member of Campaign Against Child Labour, it has completed a survey in 10 nos of schools of Larjigerh block this year where DAPTA has planned for long time intervention.
- This year we have trained 400 nos. of adolescent girls in life skill education, adolescent reproductive sexual health care, STI and HIV/AIDS and trafficking with the support of UNICEF and WCD Department.



### PROJECT SANDHAN (ISSUE BASE ADVOCACY & RIGHTS)

In this programme, DAPTA has given priority to fight against Domestic Violence, single women problem, trafficking and girls empowerment.

#### Domestic Violence

DAPTA had organized one sensitization yatra from 25<sup>th</sup> November to 8<sup>th</sup> December, 2015 in several blocks of Kalahandi District by covering 23 panchayat. In this rath yatra we have sensitized near about 79000 people on domestic violence and 25 nos. of case noticed on the spot, distributed leaflet with a final meeting at Bhawanipatna. Also through the Family Counselling Centre we have lodged 58 nos. of cases and settled most of the SABALA training. As part of the objective, DAPTA has provided Capacity Building training to adolescent girls and in this year DAPTA has provided life skill education training to 240 nos. of teen age girls with exposure to different institution like police station, hospital, railway station, govt. offices, banks etc to enhance their knowledge and skill. Also DAPTA has completed a brief study on single women and destination unknown children in the District.
