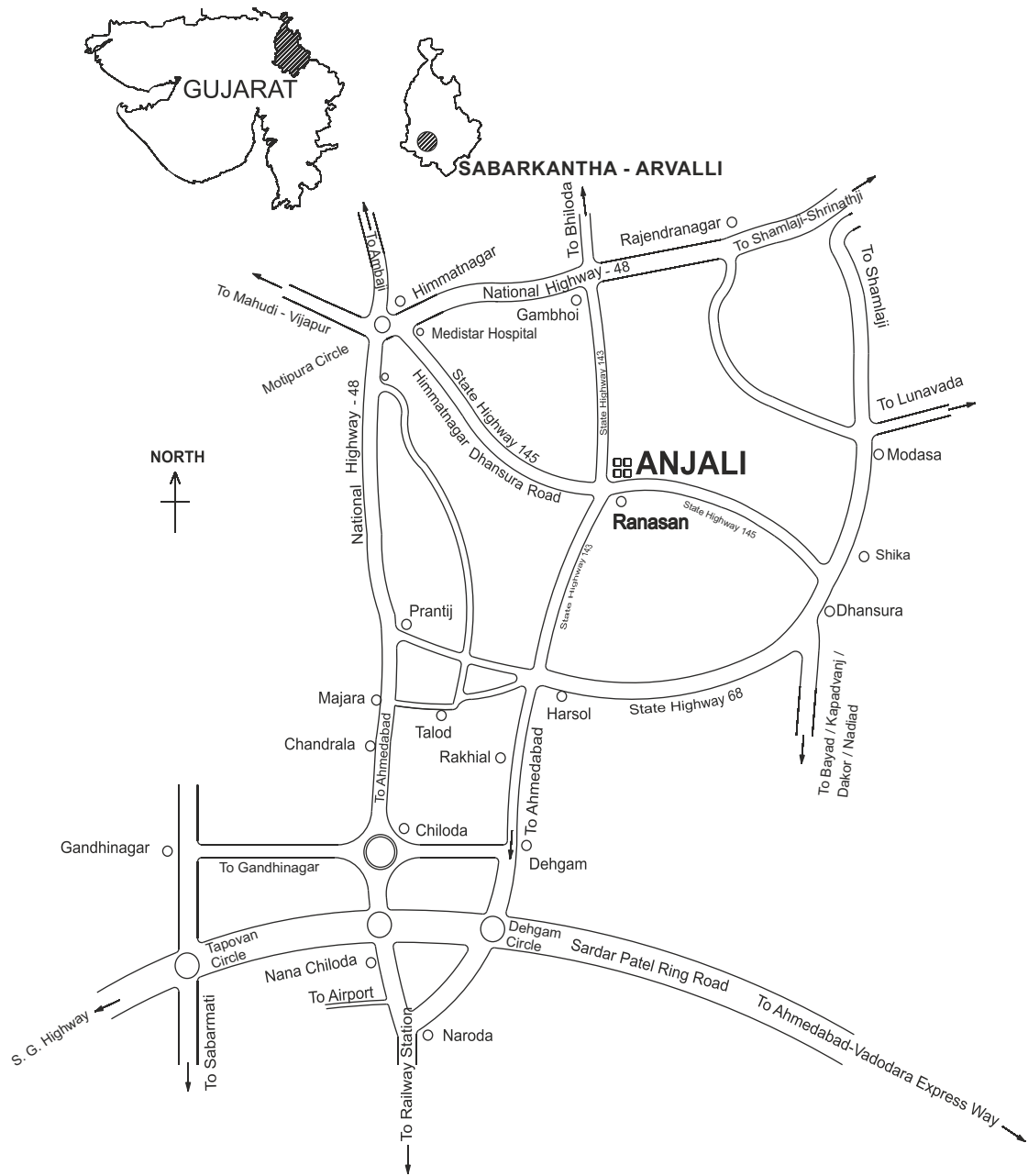

It is pleasure presenting Annual Report for the year 2021-2022.

29th January, 2022 was 33rd foundation day of Anjali. We celebrated this day through small get-together with workers in which senior workers shared their experience of last 33 years.

Due to Covid-19 the patient population in the hospital and the other activities were less. As Covid-19 decreased by the year end, the hospital and other activities resumed as earlier.

From the work that could be done for Covid-19 and the work done during the 2001 earthquake in Kutch, we realized that in time of humanly disasters one has to plunge in relief work and once the work starts all others join in. These experiences will be immensely useful in the future to the institution and the workers.

Reaching out to the interior villages in form of weekly eye camps and three surgical operation camps (outreach health services) the organisation is developing relations, contacts and credibility with the interior villages of Sabrakantha and Arvalli districts.

Tree Plantation has been a unique experience over last 10-12 years. The 7500 standing trees are being protected, taken care of and efforts are being made to use the program as an education tool for the school children and the residents of surrounding areas.

Anjali's dedicated workers, well-wishers, friends, national-international organisations and individual donors are the reason behind sustained activities of Anjali Hospital, the live contacts with 1900 families of 52 villages through women's program and tree plantation.

We thank all of them and look forward to continued support and assistance in the coming years.

Anjali was established in the year 1988. The activities of the organization were initiated on 29th January 1989.

The founders, after completing higher education founded Anjali in order to use their skills & capabilities for the poor and the needy.

Anjali is a voluntary organization based in village Ranasan. Ranasan with population of 5000 is a village in Talod taluka of Sabarkantha district in north Gujarat in India.

Beginning was made with health activities, the poor and the needy being the target population. The health activities developed progressively and other activities were included as the needs were perceived.

At present the activities of Anjali are, a 50 bed Anjali Hospital, women's program in 52 interior villages (on the platform of saving groups) and environment enrichment program. Organization is inclined towards development programs for children, youth, and villages.

The soil in Ranasan and its vicinity is rocky & sandy and the climate is dry, windy, hot during 7-8 months of the year and cold during the winter months. The rainfall is less and unpredictable. There are two rivers which run if there is ample of rainfall. There are few lakes & other sources of water. The principal vocation of the people is agriculture. There are few industries in the vicinity. The level of education is low. Most of the population is economically & socially weak.

The majority of the population of this area comes from the communities of Thakors, Dalits, Ravals, Vagharis, Banjaras, Vadi, Pagi, Rabari samaj and migrant adivasi labourers. Most of them earn their livelihood as agriculture or miscellaneous labour. They have not made much progress either economically or socially. This group of people along with other economically weak & distressed section of the population are the main beneficiaries of Anjali's activities.

Vision and Mission Statement

Vision

Promotion of health & all-round development of rural population without any distinction of caste, colour or creed.

Mission

1. Activities promoting community health & primary health care.
2. Rational, ethical & subsidized rural hospital services.
3. Empowering education to women, children, youth and over all development of rural population & rural areas.
4. Environment enrichment by tree plantation, rain water harvesting & use of renewable energy.
5. Activities conducive to & fostering moral and ethical values.

(1) Health

Anjali Hospital is pivot (centre) of Anjali's activities. The services of Anjali Hospital have been developed keeping the needy people of this interior area at the centre, the benefits of which they are deriving. To establish services ordinary people can understand and afford, three structures had to be arranged which are established by now. In this report, the information about these three structures is given in detail.

1. To Provide Basic and Essential Health Services:

- i. Emergency services which are available 24x7 and provided by MBBS doctors.
- ii. Rational treatment (without preference to injections, i.v bottles and tonic bottles and that which is actually needed) of day-to-day common disease which the patient can afford and develop an understanding that such conditions can be cured with good amount of rest and simple medicines.
- iii. Ante Natal Care (A.N.C) for 9 months, 24x7 child birth facility, availability of treatment for miscarriages and complaints of pregnant women 24x7.
- iv. Treatment of New born and Children.
- v. Diagnosis and treatment of T.B and facility for admissions of severely ill T.B patients.
- vi. Dental care
- vii. Availability of affordable medicines and treatment of long term/lifelong medical conditions like Asthma, Diabetes, BP, Heart diseases, Epilepsy, Respiratory disease and mental disease.
- viii. Availability of examination, diagnosis and treatment of disease of eye, and well organised and regular Free IOL cataract operations, affordable phaco cataract surgery.
- ix. For old people, facility of treatment during illness and as per their needs.
- x. Facility of common surgical operations like hernia, hydrocele, congenital hernia, fissure, fistula, piles and ordinary and frequent small benign tumors like lipoma, cysts and facility to conduct biopsy.
- xi. Availability of visiting doctors for disease of Skin, E.N.T, Psychiatric diseases and Retina.

2. Second structure which facilitates and supports the services of the first structure:

- i. Essential services like laboratory, X-Ray, Sonography of pregnant women and 24x7 oxygen supply with the help of oxygen generating plant.
- ii. Availability of branded and generic medicines in the hospital even during emergency so that the patients do not have to go outside for medicines.
- iii. Availability of nutritious and hygienic food & milk periodically in the day.
- iv. Attachment with outside laboratories for blood investigations, biopsy, X-Ray, Sonography, CT scan, MRI and consultations where it is possible to provide concessions to deserving patients on account of Anjali Hospital.
- v. 24x7 Ambulance services.
- vi. Counselling Services.
- vii. Outreach services in form of Eye and Surgical Operation Camps. Arrangements have been made to bring and perform free surgeries. The patients and their relations who come for Surgeries are exposed to the other services of the hospital which they can utilize.

3. Concessional medicines, investigations, operations and treatment

An arrangement of providing concessions in which an ordinary man can walk in without hesitation and derive benefits of services of the hospital and those people in need of life long/long term treatment for their diseases can for years come and take their medicines regularly.

This arrangement has to be such that not the trustees but responsible employees and doctors can give 50%,75% or 90 % concessions as per the needs of the patients.

Such a liberal arrangement of concessions is bound to be loss incurring. Without government grant, the involvement of donors and well-wishers has been an important factor because of which things have been possible and presently it seems it will be sustained.

Next Annual Report will highlight the involvement of enlightened donors.

Second wave of Covid-19:

A detailed information about the “Corona Sarvar Kendra” was given in the previous year Annual Report.

To that we would like to add few things which are as follows:

When we started knowing that the people of interior villages were being affected with Covid-19 and there was shortage of beds in hospital and oxygen and on getting disheartening information about the rates of one day charges of the hospital beds and oxygen bottles we had feelings that “there is a battle going on around us and we have just become spectators”. Under such a situation Shri Hansrajbhai Sankhla & Dr. Dineshbhai Prajapati of Himatnagar and Shri Jitendrabhai Shah of Tipsons Financial Services, Ahmedabad called us and inquired “have you thought of doing anything”, “if you start something then we are with you”. Such phone calls helped us shake off the hesitations and “Corona Sarvar Kendra” was started and with the financial assistance from well-wishers and donors we could treat majority of admitted patients free of any charge.

This unprecedented event bringing together the workers, well-wishers and donors on the same page imparted many lessons and realisation that when any difficult but essential work is started for the people then the workers, community and the government will join in.

Other important occasions and activities during 2021-2022

- 33rd foundation day of Anjali was celebrated with get together of workers of Anjali.
- Appreciation certificate for work done in PMJAY by Collector, Sabarkantha.
- A program for examination of Retina of patients of Diabetes taking long term treatment at Anjali Hospital which was started in the Retina Center.
- Fire safety System was installed and Anjali Hospital was given Fire N.O.C.
- “MANBHAI BHATT NAGARIK SANMAN AWARD” by Shishu Vihar, Bhavnagar was given to Anjali along with 74 other organisations by Param Pujya Morari Babu on the occasion of "Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav".
- Oxygen Plant was installed with assistance from Sewa International, Canada Inc.

Respect for Anjali - An Event

For Eye camps there are frequent publicity visits in the surrounding villages which gives us many experiences. One such experience is shared below:

Those people coming to Anjali Hospital have good or bad experiences which are expressed as per their experience. Based on that they share those experiences with others. These experiences get converted in action in form of donation in kind, financial assistance or respect for us.

Eye camp publicity was in Vadagam village which is on highway. We went for lunch in Umiya Bhojnalaya. The owner was known so we greeted him with Ram-Ram he also reciprocated. Having finished lunch went to pay bill which he did not accept. He was elderly and a regular patient of Anjali Hospital and as he was insistent, we did not persist. When we went second time, his son was there. Served us lunch with warmth but did not accept the bill. We told him that for once it was accepted by us not repeatedly, we will be coming repeatedly so you should take the bill. He said Anjali is blessing for the people of this area. In such hard economic times, no one can provide such services. We cannot do the things you are doing but at least we can serve you food..... whether you come in publicity or camp, it is 2 or 12, you will have to come and eat here only.

“My father” is taking medicines for a long time from Anjali and “My grandfather” lived long because of medicines from Anjali. Who provides such services in such times. We will also get some blessings along with you. Mehulbhai has retired from Army. In his own way he has valued Anjali's services and given expression. Salute to him and his understanding.

(2) Women's Program:

Women's program is part of mutually useful social activity in which various activities are performed during the year. During this year also monthly meetings of saving groups were held in which savings/loans and different activities of the saving groups were regularly held. The members of the new saving groups which were formed during the year were given training of their role in the saving group and leaders of the existing groups were given training regarding increasing their own development and understanding and making them capable of bringing changes and improvements to make saving groups capable. Every year women eagerly wait for the vegetable seeds which are given to them regularly. By now they are habituated to sowing and up bringing. As a result their family members, neighbors, near & dear ones are able to eat and relish vegetables. 8th March means Women's Day and previously we had to explain to them that, it can also be celebrated. But now they organise a rally in their village and inform us. The self-confidence can be felt the way they raise slogans. They take round of whole village and enjoy the occasion. This year, along with rally in their own village they had desire that women from different villages come to Ranasan and hold a maharally (grand rally). Between 1st March to 8th March 1281 women members of 83 saving groups took out rallies in their respective 30 villages. On 8th March, on Women's Day 200 members of 13 villages came to Ranasan and took out a Maharally in which members of Ranasan saving groups also joined. As per their desire after the Maharally it got converted in to a meeting in which 300 members participated. Trustees of Anjali, workers of Anjali also joined the rally and provided motivation which increased enthusiasm of the women.

Compared to past, now they go out on social and other occasions but even then it is felt that they eagerly await the yearly picnic in bus with the group members. They start reminding as the time approaches.

Our approach has been to include educational components which are useful to them in day to day living along with enjoying themselves and having a nice time.

This year organic farming, vermicompost and visit to well-kept and maintained cattle sheds were the educational component along with darshan of Khedbrahma and Ambaji temples. After the yearly "Pravas", for the women along with their husbands who showed interest in organic farming and vermicompost fertilisers, a separate visit to the farms were arranged to give them details about organic farming and making vermicompost fertiliser. Our intention being they start doing what they saw and learnt. We will continue motivating them so that they utilize this educational exposure.

Shri Vithalbhai Patel of Pratappura Village in Idar taluka has successfully experimented organic farming. The members were taken to his farm for giving exposure about organic farming and vermicompost fertiliser.

Shri Pratapbhai along with his family members and villagers warmly welcomed the women, explained in simple language and he along with his wife served them with tea and light refreshments.

The educational visit was facilitated by voluntary organisation of Narottam Lalbhai Group, one of their worker was deputed with visiting women from Anjali. We are grateful to Shri Narottam Lalbhai Trust and their coordinator Shri Vinodbhai for their assistance.

(3) Environment Enrichment Program

One decade of Journey with Environment

Anjali's herculean efforts at transforming yesterday of grazing land into tomorrow.

To move ahead and sustain and develop the nation, constructing roads, railways, residences and new industries, the efforts that were made took the environment which is essential for sustaining mankind very lightly and misused it. To make progress in life and improve standard of living we have used environment a lot, whatever is left, let us preserve for the future generations. With such types of thoughts, we joined "Panai Yatra". After which we started developing existing lakes with people's participation. Four lakes were developed. After that from 2010-2011 onwards our journey with trees and environment started. In the very beginning during 2009-2010 & 2010-2011 272 trees were planted on both the sides of Dhansura-Himatnagar road by Anjali's staff. The staff members of Anjali and volunteers worked with sincerity and enthusiasm. Persons who never did hard work of digging also participated. All the trees planted, developed nicely which motivated us to plant more trees. As a part of our efforts at enriching environment we developed Rayan Lake located in grazing land of Ranasan village. Rayan lake is in centre of the grazing land. The mere size of the area instilled hope of possibilities of environment enrichment and conservation. Initially 104 trees were planted around the lake. This way, Anjali took first step of the journey. The rayan area is rocky waste land with no water. How to take care of the trees after planting was a question. Initially the trees were planted with help of water tankers and the trees were taken care of. This lasted for several years but it was felt that there has to be a permanent solution to this. As it is said "if you really want to do good work and if you start, all the help will come around". A resident of Ranasan who is a well wisher of Anjali has a well in his land, made arrangement to provide water. Pipelines were laid in the whole area and water points were made in the whole area. The number of new trees planted increasing every year. All the trees were periodically taken care of. It takes considerable time for the newly planted tree to be rooted and develop. As this was rocky area the growth was much slow which was frustrating at times. But after the period of 10 years when we go to the Rayan area, we see all green trees around. Added to this, there are many fruits bearing trees which provide food to birds and the trees provide residences and nesting for the birds. Seeing all this there is a sense of fulfilment and are motivated to do still something new. Many have cooperated in this program. Some gave financial assistance, few came all the way and helped in plantation and care, someone gave tractor and water

tanker and someone by himself look after the trees. With help and cooperation of all there is a beginning of forrestation of the area. Today there are standing and thriving 7500 trees. There is a very different sense of joy and experience whenever we go there. During this journey of a decade, from the time of marking places for trees to grow them and maintain them, there are stages and many steps. There are many things to be done. If listed it will 25 small and big things to be done. At present a protection PVC net is being added on top of the existing tree guard. Which is to be followed by putting local and botanical name of the tree. So that in future, people visiting the place can appreciate the scientific approach and are motivated to do such activities with involvement of community.

Effects of Tree Plantation:

- * In development of Rayan Lake and grazing land of the village it is first time that people from the village cooperated and a small effort made earlier was seen developing in to big achievement.
- * There is likelihood that encroachment of wasteland, grazing land was prevented.
- * The trees have become big and are shelters for the birds.
- * The existing local trees were protected.

(4) Development of Workers:

- * A musical feast was organised on the occasion of surgical eye camp. Joy Mehta, son of longtime associate of Anjali, Dr. Timir Mehta, Dermatologist.
- * Foundation day of Anjali was celebrated with a get together with workers in which there were discussion, songs and games.
- * Different program brings freshness in work so whenever there are participative programs in friendly institutions, workers participate.

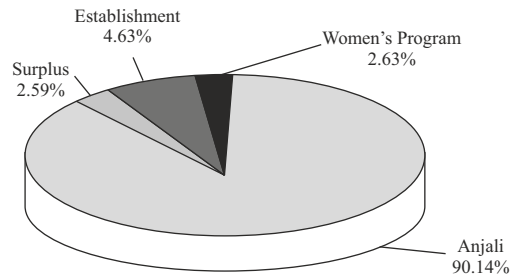

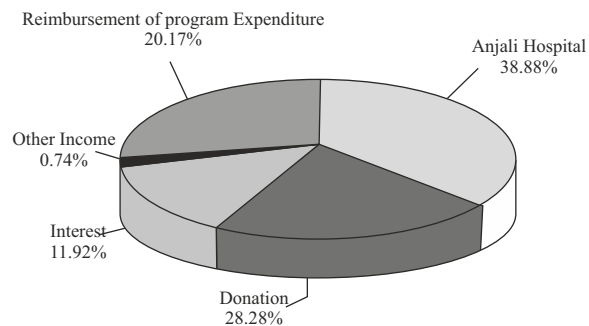
