

I am pleased to present the activity and financial report of Anjali for the year 2023-2024.

Looking back at last year activities, health activities could be delivered satisfactorily. In the Eye department Cornea centre, a new facility was added. On medicine side Epilepsy centre was started. The Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD) are rising day by day. Anjali Hospital has NCD clinic since many years, and because of subsidised investigations and medicines significant number of patients are coming regularly for the treatment of NCDs. Now we are desirous of going to the community and do NCD work, in which to find new cases, to ensure & monitor that patients continue the lifelong treatment regularly and counsel them.

Women's activity has completed 20 years. The situation has changed a lot since the program started. Young women are joining as members now and because of their understanding and education there is increase in the acceptance. This year the women members participated enthusiastically in the "EKATVA BHAVNA MILAN", "MANDAL NA SANGE-PRAGATINA PANTHE" program (The Women's Program is financially supported by SHARE AND CARE FOUNDATION, U.S.A. since last four years. We are grateful for their support)

The 35th Annual Day (Foundation day was celebrated in the presence of Pujya Swami Viditatmanand Saraswati (Tatva Tirth, Shilaj, Ahmavad) and Dr Mihir Joshi (Jyoti Eye Hospital, Visnagar). The staff members exhibited various department activities. In addition, throughout the year various activities and programs were organized to mark completion of 35 years of activities. On this occasion I thank all the friends of staff, friends and well-wishers of Anjali. I sincerely hope that in the coming years also we work together and keep performing humanitarian activities.

I heartily thank all the friends, relations, well-wishers and donors for providing help, cooperation, assistance, warmth and staying with Anjali. And pray almighty that we stay together and keep performing humanitarian activities in coming years.,

Anjali was established in the year 1988. The activities of the organization were initiated on 29th January 1989.

The founders, after completing higher education founded Anjali in order to use their skills & capabilities for the under privileged.

Anjali is a voluntary organization based in village Ranasan. Ranasan with population of 4000 is a village in Talod taluka of Sabarkantha district in north Gujarat in India

Beginning was made with health activities, the under privileged being the target population. The health activities developed progressively and other activities were included as the needs were perceived.

At present the activities of Anjali are, a 75 bed Anjali Hospital, Women's program in 53 interior villages (on the platform of saving groups) and environment enrichment program. Organization is inclined towards development programs for children, youth, and villages.

The soil in Ranasan and its vicinity is rocky & sandy and the climate is dry, windy, hot during 7-8 months of the year and cold during the winter months. The rainfall is less and unpredictable. There are two rivers which flow if there is ample of rainfall. There are few lakes & other sources of water. The principal vocation of the people is agriculture. There are few industries in the vicinity. The level of education is low. Most of the population is economically & socially weak.

The majority of the population of this area comes from the communities of Thakors, Dalits, Ravals, Vagharis, Banjaras, Vadi, Pagi, Rabari samaj and migrant Adivasi labourers. Most of them earn their livelihood as agriculture or miscellaneous labour. They have not made much progress either economically or socially. This group of people along with other economically weak & distressed section of the population are the main beneficiaries of Anjali's activities.

Vision and Mission Statement

Vision

Promotion of health & all-round development of rural population without any distinction of caste, colour or creed.

Mission

- 1. Activities promoting community health & primary health care.
- 2. Rational- ethical & subsidised rural hospital services.
- 3. Empowering education to women, children, youth and over all development of rural population and rural areas.
- 4. Environment enrichment by tree plantation, rain water harvesting & use of renewable energy.
- 5. Activities conducive to & fostering moral and ethical values.

(1) <u>Health</u>

Health is an important field of activity of Anjali. People who are under privileged, socially and economically unsecured are provided highly subsidised hospital and outreach services.

New Services added during year 2023-2024:

I) Paediatric Doctor OPD.

Child specialist comes daily in the morning. Conducts OPD and also examines the new born patients in the hospital. The hospital has a NBSU (New Born Stabilisation Unit) in which those new born who require care are admitted.

ii) <u>Treatment facility for Epilepsy patients</u>

Epilepsy patients are provided subsidised treatment in Anjali hospital and there is a significant number of such patients. As there were services of Neuro physician available in nearby Himatnagar town, he is called to conduct Epilepsy clinic once a month. Patients are provided subsidised treatment under his guidance.

III) <u>Cornea Clinic</u>

Patients with problems of Cornea were referred to Ahmedabad, very few referred patents could go to Ahmedabad. And as there was no Cornea facility under charitable set up in Sabarkantha and Arvalli districts and with availability of Cornea surgeon in nearby Modasa town, once a week Cornea clinic was started. Shortly if the circumstances are favorable Cornea surgery which is primary now, will be scaled up.

IV) Addition to General Surgeon Services.

Since last many years, general Surgeon was coming on every Saturday. From this year, another Surgeon is appointed to come on every Wednesday. From this year, General Surgical Operations will be performed twice a week.

V) Mental Health Clinic

Psychiatrist is coming to Anjali Hospital since last four years but there was no provision of subsidised medicines and counselling. These services were added during the year. Psychiatrist visits hospital twice a week.

VI) <u>New Instruments and Equipment:</u>

New Instruments were purchased for various departments like Eye, Retina, Operation Theatre, Laboratory and Office.

Out Reach Health Services

In order to reach far flung villages, Anjali Hospital conducts one cataract operation camp in a week and three Surgical Operation camps in a year. After availability of Bus Cataract operation camp and Surgical operation camps in Poshina (120 Kms far) and Megharaj taluka (70 Kms far) two eye camps and one surgical operation camps have become possible. Villagers eagerly look forward to these camps.

Revaben (name changed), aged 22, from village Dachka, Meghraj taluka. She has been suffering from seizures since childhood. She consulted in big hospitals of big cities like Ahmedabad but didn't get any satisfactory results. Her seizure medications were discontinued, leading to severe consequences. However, no one can harm whom God protects!!

One day while she was cooking, she had a seizure, and no one was at home, her leg fell into the stove, causing severe burns. She visited a nearby government hospital. They were dressing wound, but there was no improvement in her leg. They advised her to go to Ahmedabad Civil Hospital. During this time, her school teacher learned about her condition and advised her to go to Anjali Hospital. She arrived at Anjali Hospital in a very dire physical state. Observing her physical and mental condition, she was admitted and treatment began. She was examined by general surgeons, Neurophysician, physician, and other doctors and the team treated her diligently. Timely medications, dressings, food, love, and warmth were provided. Over time, skin grafting was done.

After everything was fine, she was discharged. The patient and her family were very happy. She wanted to study but couldn't due to poor financial conditions. Her treatment at Anjali Hospital was provided free of charge. She expressed her desire to join the health work.

Special activities to celebrate 35th year of foundation of Anjali:

Butter Milk Centre

Butter milk centre was started in month of April'23 to give relief to patients and their relatives in the abnormal heat in the months of May and June. Every patient and their relations were provided buttermilk free of charge. It was the first such experiment in Anjali Hospital. What was seen was very positive, inclusive and an occasion to express empathy towards one another. This programm was by Anjali Hospital but right from second day people started giving their names for the contribution, the condition was, they have to themselves bring required number of Amul Butter Milk packets and paper glasses. Local people, outsiders, some members of hospital staff and above all some saving groups came and served buttermilk happily.

Blood Donation Camp

Accidents, childbirth, operations, cancer, Thalassemia and other diseases require blood. Demand is always more than supply. On the occasion of celebrations of 35th Foundation day "Blood Donation Camp" was organized in collaboration with Indian Red Cross Society, Paladi, Ahmedabad. 50 Women and men gave invaluable blood donation.

35th Annual Day Function:

Anjali completed 35 years of its Foundation on 28-01-2024 and entered 36th year. The foundation day was celebrated in the presence of **Pujya Swami Viditatmanand Saraswati** of "Tatvatirth", Shilaj, Ahmedabad and Dr. **Mihirbhai Joshi** of "Jyoti Eye Hospital, Visnagar. Gujarat. On 28-01-2024 a get together program of staff members and their family members was organised in the presence of Pujya Swamiji and Dr. Mihirbhai. Those staff members who completed 15 years were honoured by both the chief guests. which was followed by dinner and Bhajan, Gujarati songs and Music program by Shri Joy Timir Mehta (son of Dr Timir Y. Mehta, visiting Dermatologist at Anjali Hospital) which was enjoyed by one and all.

On 28-01-2024 the 35th Foundation Day was celebrated with the wellwishers, donors and friends. On both days Pujya Swamiji and Dr. Mihirbhai graced all the celebrations and blessed Anjali. Both the guests visited the site of water conservation and Tree plantation programm and planted one plant each at the site.

2. <u>Women's Program</u>

There is a lot of diversity in activities other than savings and borrowing in the women's program. Compared to beginning there is a change in figures, activities, savings and reasons for loan. Seeing other saving groups, the women are coming forward to form new saving groups. In other programs, such as annual meetings the number of women attending has also increased. Thus, the interest, colour of the activity is now changing, joy and enthusiasm is increasing.

This year's annual meeting was attended by 1,404 women members. As in previous years, we explained their saving group's annual accounts and raised awareness about mental health. Physical health is equally important when it comes to mental health. For this, every member was given the plant of drumstick. Detailed information about its benefits were explained. Vegetable seeds have become a part of annual savings. Along with plant and seeds, a memento of small mobile purse was given. Three training sessions were organised for the leaders of the saving groups. During these sessions, the leaders of the newly formed saving groups were trained on the ideal role of a leader in saving group and accounting methods. A total of 58 leaders participated in this training program.

Every three years, a program of all the saving group members called "EKATAVA BHAVNA MILAN" "MANDAL NA SANGE-PRAGATINA PANTHE" is organised. The name of this program itself tells us that it is not just the women from one village or one group who are part of this program, but many villages, groups have joined together in this program where they can experience sense of unity, where they meet everyone, learn about each other's progress, and enjoy food together. Such a large program was conducted this year with the aim of developing the quality of peace and patience, in which everyone participated enthusiastically. In the program, the women member from the groups gave social messages such as the eradication of superstitions and gender equality, importance of organic farming, and achievements of women in various fields through dances and drama.

In order to encourage and bless them, the program was organized in the presence of Param Pujya Gyanmayaprana Mataji (Rishikesh). The program was conducted by the women members themselves. The preparations for

songs, garba, dance are done for weeks with enthusiasm and the presentation of the program with such a vast audience was done successfully with courage. Thus the progress through their presence in saving groups was visible. The program was attended by 1306 women members and 48 invited men from the project villages.

On March 8, "World Women's Day", the women members have enthusiastically organized rallies in 22 villages on these days. The members of these groups suggested that they want to take out rally in Ranasan village (where Anjali is located). So, a rally was taken out in village Ranasan. which was attended by 176 women members. The staff of Anjali, trustees, administrators also participated and encouraged the participants.

A new thing that is observed is, earlier they were not able to answer freely

when they were asked something as well as, they were not able to grasp the purpose of outside visits. Now the situation has changed. They understand the purpose of out side visits and when some visitors ask them something they are able to answer them. They are able to compare the activities done till now, are able to clearly tell the difference between yesterday and today, and not only that they can logically present it and explain.

The bank account of each saving group has been opened independently in the name of its own saving group in a nationalized bank. The transaction of money is carried out by the signature of the leader members of the group decided by the resolution of the saving group. The saving group is administered by members of the saving group themselves. None of Anjali's workers have name in the bank account. Anjali's worker acts as a facilitator only. Each saving group is a self-help saving group in the true sense. Women save on their own, start internal lending as funds accumulate. The accumulated fund is used as per the needs of the members, and keep saving and lending. Thus, the savings continue to grow and their different needs are satisfied. For the purpose of safety, they do not lend outside the saving group. The interest rate of the loan is decided by the women members of the saving group. Mostly the loan is without interest because the income from the loan is distributed to the members according to each member's savings.

An effort has been made below to show the scale of saving groups, the total savings of all these groups, total loans given till 31^{st} March' 2024 to the members and loans returned. If the amount of savings of all the groups is added, it is Rs 2,50,27,391, total of loans taken till now is Rs 8,23,59,500 and the loans returned amounts to Rs 6,78,09,758. So, in relation to savings the loans taken amount to 3-4 times the savings, which shows that the loans are returned in time and the rupee keeps circulating.

Small Savings and Big outcomes

In Charanvanta village Rasilaben has joined Gajeshwari saving Group. She is regular. Agriculture and animal husbandry are her main occupations. Her nature is hardworking, so keeps working. Her land was pledged. She decided to release the land of her farm which was pledged. She took loan from her saving group and released the pledged land. She repaid the loan and again took loan from the saving group and made a water bore in her land for watering the farm. She was able to get rid of her debts by farming well and also progress economically.

Effectiveness of Guidance:

The topics of annual meetings which are held at Anjali are chosen after careful understanding and careful consideration of their needs. With a thought that it would be useful to the wider community of women, somewhere in a good way, decided to give an insight into the issue of community mental health in this year's annual meetings. It proved to be very useful.

The women member of one of our own saving group was on mental health medication but was irregular.She did not understand and appreciate its importance. Having been a part of good discussion about this in this year's annual meeting, she felt how hard the organization is working for us. Now I have to be regular in taking medicines. This was a echo of good faith towards each other. She became regular from irregular and now she behaves very well and has become normal.

This is the positive outcome of the issues selected in the annual meetings....

Capable and Guiding Leader:

Dhuliben is one of the leaders in the Navanagar Saving Group of Nani Chichano village. She is less educated but diligent, of calm nature, she learns patiently and understand others. Takes great care of the regularity of her saving group. She herself goes for bank work. While working, she developed a lot of skills and started writing accounts and takes special care not to make mistakes. Seeing her working and the way the members of the saving group were utilizing their savings for their needs the other women of the village informed Dhuliben that they wanted to form a saving group.. Then Dhuliben told this to Anjali's workers and gathered the women who wanted to form a saving group on the day of their meeting and gave a very good and excellent understanding about saving group in the presence of the workers. No issue remained and a new saving group was formed on the same day. The new saving group is also doing well. Looking at this, it seems that the working style of Anjali's workers is so effective that the confidence of this leader of the group increased and she was able to motivate others.

Adolescent-Girls and Boys Program:

249 adolescent boys and 400 adolescent girls are part of this programm. The adolescent girls were given various training. Confusion faced by the adolescent girls at this age, physical and mental changes, safety and security, body language, friendship, addiction, non – abuse, lifestyle and similar topics are explained through different methods.

Gave extensive self-defense training to girls of 9^{th} and 10^{th} classes, in which how to do self-defense? How to be mentally and physically strong? and many such things were covered.

Activities of primary school children:

Regular awareness programmes are conducted in primary schools. We work with a total of 891 children of standards 3rd to 8th. Programs were organized regarding some important issues to be conveyed to them like use of nail cutters, soap, water hygiene, stay away from addiction, importance of nutritious food, not to use abusive words, personal safety and security, inappropriate touch, etc. In addition, 172 children of Standard-3 have been given "Galla" (saving bank boxes) to motivate them to save. A children's book fair was organized in the Ranasan high school with the help of, ARCH, DHARAMPUR for children of 1st to 8th standards. 826 students of 13 schools visited the book fair. 41 students and 4 teachers of one school with great curiosity visited Anjali Hospital while returning to their village

3. <u>Environment Enrichment Programme :</u>

Tree plantation, taking care of planted trees and conserving and protecting the local trees along with conserving the existing lake are the main environment enrichment activities undertaken. This program is 15 years old now.

On the occasion of "World Environment Day" on June 5, villagers and staff members were invited to visit the place. What is the significance of this program? Why is it necessary? We talked about what we should and can do and what a big result of small tasks can be seen.

Again, in the end of June'23, staff members and villagers were invited for planting trees, Total 600 trees planted. All participated with enthusiasm and joy.

In the end of March'24 activity of deepening and broadening of the lake was started which is likely to continue for one and half months.

On the occasion of 35^{th} year celebrations videography and photography of the area was done.



4. <u>Staff Development:</u>

- To accomplish the objectives of the organization, the contribution of the workers is an important and main factor. Workers of any organization are its strong foundations. A workshop named "GHADTAR" was organized for the selected workers of Anjali so that the socially beneficial activities of Anjali are performed well, preserving the values, effectively and result oriented.
- On 14.4.2023 and 06-06-2023 a seminar was organized by Dr Amish Patel (Retina Specialist) giving guidance on Operation Theatre Protocols/ Scrubbing/Autoclave.
- Writing workshop: Documentation is of utmost importance in a voluntary organization. A day-long reporting workshop (writing workshop) was organized with the objective of increasing the capacity of the workers working in various departments of Anjali to document their work. Shri Sanjay Dave, came to train in writing from Charkha Development Communication Network. Training in report writing, case study, daily notes and monthly report was given.
- A get together of family members of workers was organized immediately after Diwali and New year.
- During this year some staff members raised funds and brough some musical instruments for prayer room and Bhajan programs.






