HIGHLIGHTS



- 830 Students referrals from 3 Zones in Chennai Dist. have been followed up in April 2020, with advisory of the childrens' health position, and information that they will be contacted again after the COVID lockdown to be directed for further medical help.
- Support for Emergency Cardiac Surgery to treat Large VSD Condition for Baby Susidharan, 4 month old boy in Chennai during lockdown (Surgery was done successfully on 1st April 2020, but due to poor health, the child passed away on 14th April 2020)

- Face Shields (Visors) have been purchased for distribution to Police Personnel who are on constant patrol to enforce COVID lockdown

Shree Sai Healing Trust has planned to distribute **essential groceries** to the **180+** families located in Rajakrishnapura village, Karnataka.

The village is home to daily wage earning families belonging to the scheduled caste and scheduled tribes that have been hard-hit by the COVID lockdown.

COVID-19 Response Activities Planned for May 2020

SSHT team members will be visiting the 3 Weekly Healthcare clinic Centers in Karnataka and the 10 centers in Tamilnadu during the third week of May 2020 to provide medicines to the patients with Hypertension, Diabetes Mellitus and those with both conditions, for a further period of 3-4 weeks

Additional visors, hand sanitisers, face masks are to be provided to the frontline workers- conservancy workers, police personnel, medical and paramedical personnel etc.
