FREE HEALTHCARE PROGRAMMES

- Total No. Of Patients*: 4,548
- No.Of Hypertensive Patients (each week): 100
- No.Of Diabetic Patients(each week): 126
- No.Of Patients with both Conditions(each week): 79
- No. Of Surgeries: 1 (Consolidated No. of Surgeries : 412)
- Consolidated No. Of Beneficiaries of Free HealthcareProgrammes : 11,73,108

*The main beneficiaries were the Tribal populations in the Ahmednagar district (100 villages with Population of 63,000)- and Nashik district (50 villages with Population of 34,000) of Maharashtra. The Trust also visited 3 free Weekly Rural Healthcare Centers in Karnataka and 11 centers in Tamilnadu to provide Medicines for 4 Weeks to the patients being treated for Hypertension, Diabetes and those with both conditions of Hypertension and Diabetes

Narayaseva was resumed at Puttaparthi (feeding 50 needy daily) and surrounding 6 villages(weekly Narayanaseva) on 12th May, and at 8 Hindupur villages (weekly Narayanaseva) on 25th May 2020 with required Permissions and ensuring adherence to preventive measures like face masks, maintaining Social Distance etc.

SSHT to Co-ordinate ALL Cardiac Camps in Chennai's District Early Intervention Centers (DEICs)

SSHT has been directed by the Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine Tamilnadu to *co-ordinate ALL Cardiac Camps of the various District Early Intervention Centers (DEIC)* of Chennai District, with Immediate Effect

HIGHLIGHTS

Support to critical-to-life surgery

- SSHT has facilitated the *Surgery for Mitral Valve Repair and ASD Closure surgery* for Baby Rakshita (1 year old girl child), D/O Mr.Saravanan (hailing from Vellore, and referred from District Early Intervention Center (DEIC) Vellore) in May 2020. The child has been discharged and is recovering well

SSHT- Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) Referral Follow-up

- RBSK Screening and follow-up will remain suspended till schools reopen for next academic year

- The Occassion was celebrated at the village with Abishekam at the Channapura Venkateshwara Swamy temple , Cake cutting by the children of the village, and distribution of Sweets and cake to the entire Village



HIGHLIGHTS- COVID RESPONSE- MAY 2020

- SSHT teams have visited many of our FREE WEEKLY Rural Healthcare Centers (11 centers in Tamilnadu, 3 Centers in Karnataka) and **provided medicines to the hypertensive and Diabetic Patients** for a period of 4 Weeks
- **Food Hampers** comprising of Essential Groceries have been provided to 170 families in **Rajakrishnapura Village** Karnataka, twice(1st May and 15th May 2020) during the month of May 2020.
- The village is home to daily wage earning families from Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes that have been hard-hit by the COVID lockdown



HIGHLIGHTS- COVID RESPONSE- MAY 2020

- Food Hampers have also been distributed to **110 Households in Channapura** (Where SAIGM is providing support for Free Weekly Healthcare Clinic and Narayanaseva)
- In addition, **Hand Wash Packets** have been distributed to the households in **Channapura Village in May 2020** with repeated advise on the Pandemic and on Preventive Measures
- **55 Nos. Visors (Medical Face Shields)** and **75 bottles Hand Sanitisers (100 ml each)** have been provided to Police Personnel in Chennai through the Police Stations in Chennai



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
