ANNUAL REPORT – 2014- 2015

North East zone Welfare Development society (NEZWDS), Non Governmental organization which came into existence in 2001 is dedicated to the cast of social justice and socio economic development of rural masses in the remote areas of North East. The North East Zone Welfare Development Society (NEZWDS) has been created an impact in the people of remote area to participate in progressing rural India as envisaged by the father of nation Mahatma Gandhi ji, North East zone Welfare Development Society believes in participation in its various activities and programmes , during the last thirteen years of its existence it has been making various fruitful efforts for making the rural masses self reliant through income generating activities, thus bringing the socio economic transformation.

Aim and objectives of NEZWDS :

9. To do the social audit of JFMC and SHG.
10. To do the training oriented program in Veterinary, Agriculture and Fishery.
11. To work and participating in Health and Family Welfare programmes of the Govt. and promotion of indigenous system of medicines and treatment.
12. To keep networking with various Government and non Governmental agencies and socio economic development as well as health care support and also take part in various programs of social development program.
13. To do training community groups with SHG, ASHA and VHSNC.
14. To do community based health programmes in Block level.
15. To do the co-ordination at district and block level with district health committee, ASHA, VHSNC Monitoring group.
16. The main thrust of North East Zone Welfare Development Society is to develop the backward and rural areas.

ARIAS Society (AACP-AF) engaged North East Zone Welfare Development Society as a district N.G.O of Kamrup district for the several activities of AACP-AF. In this financial year 2014 to 2015, there after North East Zone Welfare Development Society as a district N.G.O of kamrup district fully involved in all the sector Agriculture, Fishery, Veterinary and Forestry. North East Zone Welfare Development Society engaged the following co-ordinator for each sector Agriculture, Fishery, Veterinary and Forestry,. For Agriculture there are three co-ordinator, three co-ordinators for Fishery , five co-ordinators for veterinary and one co-ordinators for Forestry and over all in charge of all sector one District co-ordinator.

The Assam Agriculture Competitiveness Project (AACP) is forwarding its main thrust towards the agricultural development as a whole. Here, the AACP-AF is trying to develop the overall agriculture by help of the scientific inclusion of machineries etc. The AACP is a joint attempt by the involvement of Line Department, NGO and the target groups for the ultimate agricultural growth.

Besides these AIRAS Society, AACP-AF Additional financing has decided to implement the livestock and three zones were selected for implementing the Pig and Goat rearing scheme. South Kamrup Zone including four blocks, Rani, Chaygaon, Bongaon and Boko. Dimoria Zone, including Dimoria Dev. Block. North Kamrup including Bezera Block, Bihdia Jajikona Dev. Block and Kamalpur Dev. Block. We the district NGO are playing the role of social mobilization and the assign field coordinators started to visit door to door of the proposed beneficiaries showed in the awareness meeting organized by the field coordinators of veterinary sector.

Agriculture

Agriculture is the main source of income for the entire national economy of India. Still a major portion of national economy depends on the agriculture sector in our country. Therefore, every rural based schemes and project are targeting development in our country.

Our assigned co-ordinator was engaged in various activities of AACP project specially related to Agriculture sector. Our co-ordinators have completed the task assigned by the line department following the activities. Among them the information dissemination, linkage with banks, screening and verification of information, distribution of STW application forms amongst the farmers. In this financial year 2014-2015 we have the following targets in agriculture sector.

Shallow Tube Well

In this financial year 2014-2015 our co-ordinators have selected 1100 beneficiary of shallow tube well in AACP-AF in Guwahati, Boko and in Rangia Division of Kamrup District. Social screening and verification has been completed and then submitted to District Agriculture office and in all the respective Engineer Office of all division of Kamrup District. After social screening and verification of all application of farmers all these machines have been disbursed jointly from respective Agriculture Engineer office from each division. Therefore in our kamrup district, in this year 2014-2015 we have now 1100 nos of shallow tube well beneficiary.



Tractor

In this financial year 2014-2015 our co-ordinators have selected twenty three numbers of beneficiary of Tractor in AACP-AF. Social screening and verification has been completed and then submitted to District Agriculture office and in the respective Engineer Office. After social screening and verification of all application of farmers all these machines have been disbursed jointly from respective Agriculture Engineer office from each division. Therefore in our kamrup district in this year 2014-2015 we have now 23 nos of Tractor beneficiary in Kamrup District.



To maintain the cohesiveness among the members of the groups participatory planning is much more important for the survival approach of the groups. The co-ordinators visited the ASG or SHG Groups and sharing with the villagers about the future planning to facilitate the ASG group or SHG for group savings and Membership contribution. Here, our co-ordinators were discussed with the groups about the raising of fund; inter lending and micro finance for the future course of action as they can make their venture sustainable for long term even after completion of the project also.

MWDP (Micro Watershed Drainage Project)

We the DNGO members along with the line department selected the site of Micro Water Shed Drainage Project (MWDP) namely Katurajan, Dhekerajan ,Bandhuajan, KrishokBandhu Bordoljan, Jalajan , Khukrakhuajan & Dongajan under Rangia sub-division and Guwahati sub-division for MWDP programme. The base line surveys of the areas have been completed in the last year 2014. Our assigned co-ordinators have completed Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) of Seven numbers of MWDP in AACP-AF in different villages under different ADO circle in Kamrup District. Now in Kamrup District we have seven numbers of WWDP. MWDP is the major part of AACP-AF and it is very benefited project to our farmers, many acres of land has been under water and the farmers could not do the cultivation through the year for this type of farmer it is very needful and useful project for them, now all the land were cultivating by the farmers which they were unable to do cultivation for many years, now with the help of this World Bank Financed project many farmers got back their land to do cultivation. We had seen it, this project is very useful to farmers and it is very high demand among the farmers and from this project not only farmers are benefited but also villagers also benefited. Global positioning survey (GPS)

Global positioning survey is the unique concept of ARIAS society by which installed shallow tube well can be identified and numbers boring also can be identified, from this it will be know that in future also that there are how many numbers of boring has been done in the field of Agriculture.

In this financial year 2014-2015, North East Zone Welfare Development Society has engaged two numbers of GPS surveyor to collect GPS data from exist shallow tube well in this financial year 2014-2015 of AACP-AF from different ADO circle of Kamrup District. Therefore assigned GPS surveyor has collected data of 1100 numbers of Global positioning survey (GPS) with machine, beneficiary photo and hard copy and submitted to PCU.



Water Sample

In this financial year 2014-2015, North East Zone Welfare Development Society has engaged two no of water sample collector to collect water from exist shallow tube well of this year,2014 of AACP-AF from different ADO circle of Kamrup District. Therefore assigned water sample collector has collected water sample 220 numbers of water sample with hard copy and submitted to PCU to test arsenic and floride. In the Kamrup District in the last year in 2013 only in one block Chaygaon in four villages namely 1.2no kalapani, 2.Bhat Khowadia, 3.Rampur and 4.Pagalardia in these villages fluoride has been found in last year. So, therefore again our assigned water sample collector collect water from installed shallow tube well and submit it to the PCU for fluoride test.



Market (Wholesale and Rural Hat)

In this financial year 2014-2015, under ARIAS Society we have three markets in Kamrup District one Wholesale market namely Hahim and two are Rural Hat Jorshimully and Khetri. North East Zone Welfare Development Society's co-ordinator engaged in the development of wholesale market and rural hat in rural areas of kamrup district . Our coordinator motivates and form a executive committee of wholesale market and rural hat and also look after all the works of market and hat and all the market has completed in time as per period given by PCU. This is also one of the most important projects for villagers and the villagers are very grateful to this project, this is a common interest project and from this all the peoples were benefited by this project.

Training Programme on maintenance and record keeping.

Our assigned Agriculture co-ordinators with District co-ordinator and with Agriculture Department had organized fourteen training programme on maintenance and record keeping in this financial year in 2014-2015 for shallow tube well and tractor in different blocks of Kamrup District and also dissemination the information regarding the record keeping and maintenance of STW and Tractor in AACP-AF.



Documentation is the prime factor of the groups for sustains in long run and this part of the project is considered as one of the major component of this project. So with line department North East Zone welfare Development Society has organized training programme on records keeping and how to maintain the machine STW and Tractor. The assigned field co-ordinators had facilitated the responsible group leader of the groups of ASG and SHG in maintaining the cash book, monthly contribution register, monthly meeting register etc in one word it is maintenance of the Master Register where all these things have been kept in the hand of group leader or secretary.



To maintain the cohesiveness among the members of the groups participatory planning is much more important for the survival approach of the groups. The co-ordinators visited the ASG and SHG and sharing with the villagers about the future planning to facilitate the SHG and ASG for group savings and Membership contribution. Here, our co-ordinators were discussed with the groups about the raising of fund; inter lending and micro finance for the future course of action as they can make their venture sustainable for long term even after completion of the project also.

Fishery Sector

Fish farming is considered as one of the most important income generating activity for self employment, especially in the state like Assam because here in Assam the need of Local fish is very high and it is to be mentioned here that still we are unable to meet up the demand. Keeping on mind these things ARIAS Society, AACP-AF has promoted the fish farmers to fish farming of the project and we the district NGO North East Zone Welfare Development Society are playing the role of social mobilization, record keeping, PRA, monthly meeting and teach them how to make savings. In this financial year 2014-2015 we have the following targets in Fishery sector.

CIG (Common Interest Group)

In this financial year 2014-2015, North East Zone Welfare Development Society has three co-ordinators for Fishery sector. The assigned Field co-ordinators fishery had executed the information dissemination task in 32 nos of cluster of CIG as our target 64.4 hac in Kamrup District along with the line department in AACP-AF. In this 64.4 hac 8 nos Pig cum fish and 25 nos of fish culture. All the civil works has been completed in the last year but in this year inputs, participatory planning , harvesting has been done , as the given time by PCU. Record keeping has been completed by the assigned field co-ordinator of fishery till the end of the project and suggest the farmers to maintain the records monthly and spread their business and also suggest them to do savings.



The assigned field co-ordinators visited all clusters and meet the beneficiaries and shared the experience with them. Documentation is the prime factor of the groups for sustains in long run and this part of the project is considered as one of the major component of this project. Frequent visit to the CIG is the main tool for observing the documentation part of the said groups. The assigned field co-ordinators had facilitated the responsible persons of the groups in maintaining the cash book, stock book, monthly contribution register, minutes of meetings etc in one word it is maintenance of the Master Register where all these things have been attached in a single register. Our co-ordinators also maintain the accounts of all 33 numbers of CIG's.



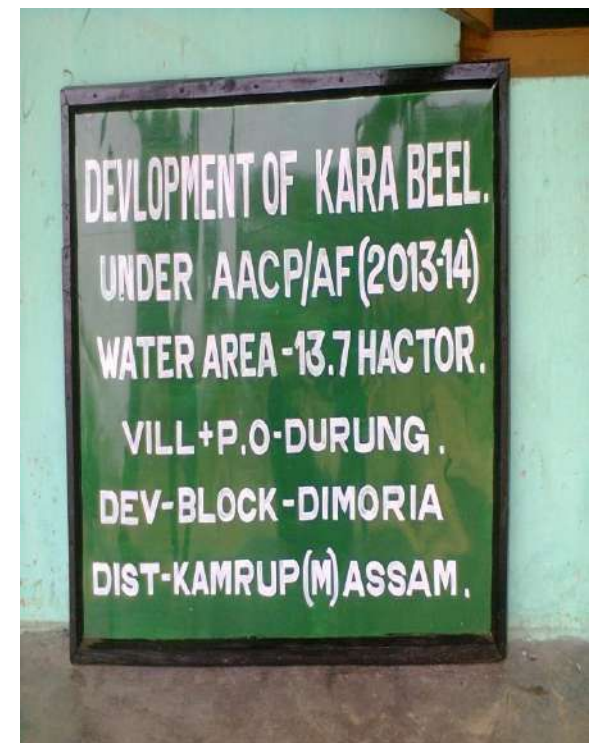

BDC

In Kamrup District 104.4 hac for BDC has been allotted from PCU. Our assigned fishery field co-ordinators selected seven numbers of BDC in consultation with the Extension Officer and Fishery Demonstrator of the concern blocks in Kamrup District along with the line department. At first our assigned field co-ordinator done Participatory Rural Appraisal (PRA) in seven numbers Beel and submitted it to the PCU and in the Fishery Department. This is to be mentioned that the main focus of the information dissemination part was given in awareness build up for the fish farmers for adopting the scientific strategy in fish culture so that the farmers may get large benefits by utilizing their local resources. All the BDC has been completed in the time given by PCU.



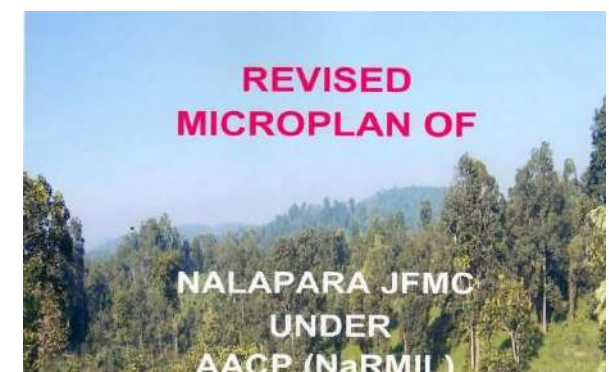
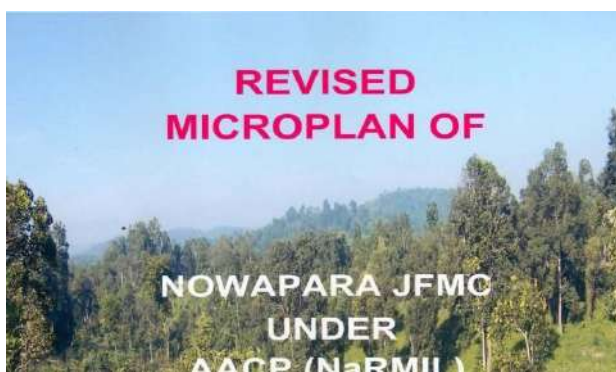
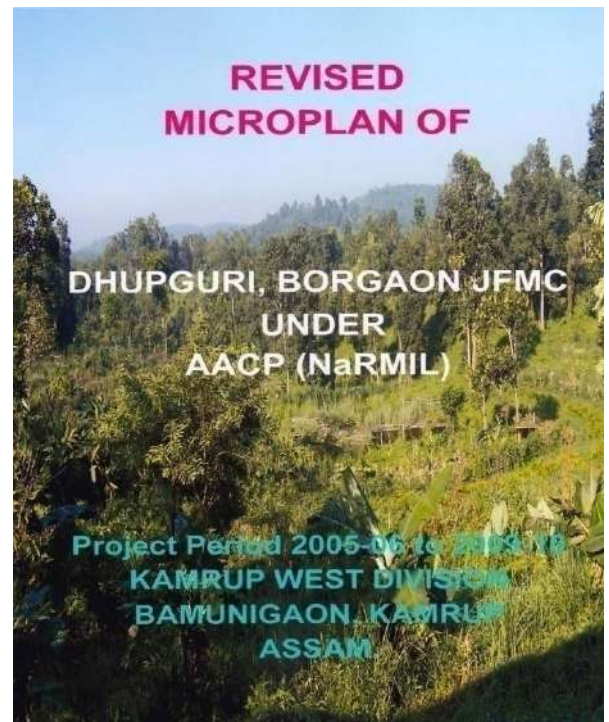
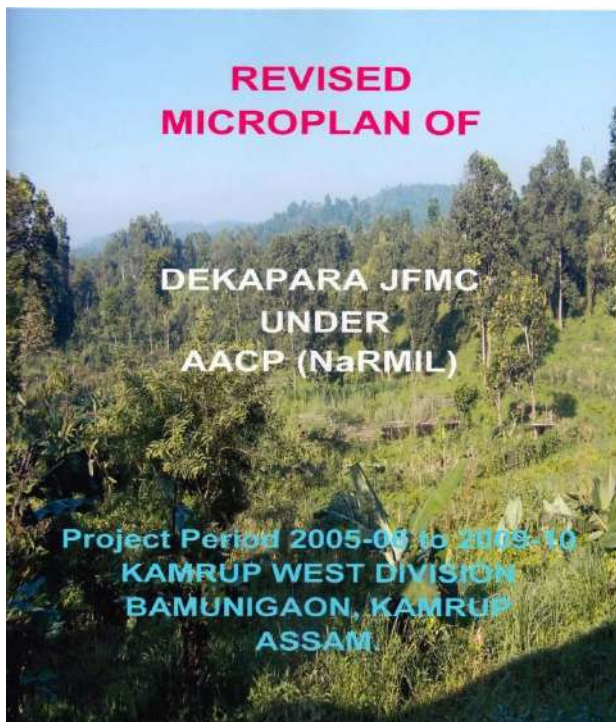

Forestry Sector

In Kamrup District in Kamrup West Division there are ten numbers of JFMC's and under this JFMC there are eighty eight numbers of SHG are surviving in JFMC. In this financial year 2014-2015, North East Zone Welfare Development Society has engaged only one co-ordinator as directed by PCU. In Forestry sector there is only one co-ordinator who have to visit the JFMC and SHG's to look after their book keeping and maintenance of accounts and collected data for preparing the list of SHG for grading to avail the grand from the project. The up-dation of cash book, monthly meeting, resolution register, monthly contribution register and loan repayment register was overviewed by our co-ordinators. The name and photo of JFMC are given below-



The assigned field co-ordinators visits to the SHG's and had organized several awareness meetings to disseminate the information about the grand to be disbursed from the project. The terms and condition of the grand to be disbursed from the project. Besides these our co-ordinators had done social audit of all JFMC's.

Frequent visit to the JFMC is the main tool for observing the documentation part of the said groups. The assigned field co-ordinators had facilitated the responsible persons of the groups in maintaining the cash book, stock book, monthly contribution register, minutes of meetings etc in one word it is maintenance of the Master Register where all these things have been attached in a single register.



Field co-ordinator of the forestry sector and conducted PRA exercise in the following JFMC's to collect the current socio economic status of the JFMC. Such as what kind of changes occurs in the last five years after intervention of the project in the village. The assigned field coordinator of forestry sector organized orientation program for the SHG regarding record keeping and policy



making. The basic subject matter of the orientation program was utilization of fund and gear up the income generating activities.



To maintain the cohesiveness among the members of the groups participatory planning is much more important for the survival approach of the groups. The co-ordinators visited the JFMC and sharing with the villagers about the future planning to facilitate the JFMC and SHG for group savings and Membership contribution. Here, our co-ordinators were discussed with the groups about the raising of fund; inter lending and micro finance for the future course of action as they can make their venture sustainable for long term even after completion of the project also.

ARIAS Society AACP-AF Additional financing, three zones were selected for implementing the Pig and Goat rearing scheme as a pilot project in kamrup District.

1. South Kamrup Zone including four blocks, Rani, Chaygaon, Bongaon and Boko
2. Dimoria Zone, including Dimoria Dev. Block.
3. North Kamrup including Rangia, Bezera Block, Bihdia Jajikona Dev. Block and Kamalpur Dev. Block.



The assign field coordinators started to visit door to door of the proposed beneficiaries showed in the awareness meeting organized by the field coordinators of veterinary sector. During the visit the field coordinators focus their thrust on the norms for getting the scheme before filing the forms for the scheme. We repeat the following points before filing the forms whether the applicants have at least two numbers of female pigs or not, whether the applicants are in the catagory of low income group or not and lastly we had taken the commitment from the applicants about the share which they will have to bourn from their own during the scheme implementation.

Moreover we have trained the group members of Goat keepers society which helps to inspire the collective farm management scientific method and abundant the traditional method. Our co-ordinators conduct formal and informal meetings and social awareness programme. Finally 150 nos group of pig beneficiaries and 150 nos group of goat beneficiaries are selected. Our co-ordinators given training to the members of pig beneficiaries and goat beneficiaries along with the line department and our co-ordinators frequently visited all the groups of pig and goat.



Hence the target of PRG and GKS group has been complete within the time given by the PCU. Our assigned co-ordinators

Our assigned veterinary co-ordinators with District co-ordinator and with Veterinary Department has organized training programme with GKS and PRG members about the examine livestock, maintenance and record keeping for PRG 2nd and 3rd phase and GKS 3rd phase in this financial year in 2014-2015 in different blocks of Kamrup District and also dissemination the information regarding the record keeping.





The most important thing about the livestock thing is to keep records daily. Documentation is the prime factor of the groups for sustains in long run and this part of the project is considered as one of the major component of this project. Frequent visit to the PRG and GKS group is the main tool for observing the documentation part of the said groups. The assigned field co-ordinators had facilitated the responsible group leader of the groups of PRG in maintaining the cash book, monthly contribution register, Male Pig register book, female pig register book, kids register book and vaccination register book and in GKS also the assigned field co-ordinators had facilitated the responsible group leader of the groups of GKG in maintaining the cash book, monthly contribution register, Male Goat register book, female goat register book, kids register book etc in one word it is maintenance of the Master Register where all these things have been kept in group leader.

Apart from the specific task included in the AACP-AF project our NGO co-ordinators were also engaged in other several activities with the beneficiaries. Among them our co-ordinators have also visited the existing groups of tractor, STW, LLP, CIG, CTG, BDC, Piggery, Goatery, MPI, DCS, JFMC and SHG monitoring their activities and also visited their crops field.

Entrepreneurship Awareness Programme

In this financial year 2014-2015, our NGO North East Zone Welfare Development Society has organized Entrepreneurship Awareness programme in Hojai College in Nogaon District, Assam. This programme is only four three days, about seventy five students both male and female students taken part in this Entrepreneurship Awareness programme, two days theoretical and one day practical in field. The main objective of this programme is to identify viable, sector wise innovative projects and ensure its commercialization to ensure individual and overall growth. To create a database of innovations in the sectors identified, float a conducive eco-system for knowledge dissemination and its application at grass root level, to ensure propagation of innovations projects through awareness , commercialize innovations, to provide follow up support and extend strategic assistance for tangible results, to facilitate network developing for forward and backward linkages, to implement reporting mechanism, to enable monitoring , handholding and evaluation of the project and to undertake research and documentation activities of the project.



Programme of NRHM

VHSC campaign

In this financial year 2014-2015, our N.G.O North East Zone Welfare Development Society conducted a VHSC campaign in the, in Gazarikandi BPHC and Mankachar CHC, as a result of data all BPL holders get the sanction sanitary latrine and make their life hygienic.

Community Mobilization

This organization has been working as a Field N.G.O in Dhubri District from 2010 to till now under National Rural Health Mission in Hazirhat and K.K.M para sub centre under Gozari Kandi P.H.C. The Reproductive child health is the main feature and how to develop the pregnancy, women health and new born child health this programme is start from 1st December 2010 to till now. As a result the death ratio of pregnancy and new born child is seen less due to the awareness of this programme and therefore most of the woman are benefited by the JSRY programmes.

Senior Citizen Health Check up camp

In this financial year 2014-2015, our N.G.O North East Zone Welfare Development Society conducted a Free Senior Citizen Health Check up camp in the, in Gazarikandi PHC and Mankachar CHC, where the Doctor has rendered free service and this organization provided free medicine to the patient.

ASHAS Training

Our N.G.O Co-ordinator who is trained from state level trainer in Bongaigaon, Mongoldoi and Guwahati. Besides these our co-ordinator is appointed as a resource person for ASHAS 6 and 7 module training from 1st to 3rd round training, which is recently finished on 10-03-2014 to 29-03-2014. Our co-ordinator has given training to 269 ASHAS under Gazarikandi BPHC and Mankachar CHC.

Community based health programmes

This organization North East Zone Welfare Development Society organized two health checkup camps in 2014 in November and at December and in kakripara, where the doctor from Gazarikandi PHC and Mankachar CHC under DM Hatsingimari rendered free services and free medicine were also distributed among the patients as per doctor's prescription. A huge numbers of people living in the remote areas were benefited by this programme.

Child Education & Adult Education

This organization North East Zone Welfare Development Society is very serious about the child education. So, this N.G.O organized a free coaching camp in South Salmara Mankachar Sub-division in summer vacation for a month for specially for the student of class IV & V, at Hatsingimari Junior College in 2014 with permission from the college principal. Here we saw that hundreds of student came and join with us in this free coaching.

Adult education is very necessary in a society to globalize the people, so this N.G.O organized a adult education programme South Salmara Mankachar Sub-division in 2014 and here we saw that hundreds of people are interested and join with us in this programme to make them literate.

Besides these this N.G.O North East Zone Welfare Development society has take a initiative to increase the literacy in remote areas by organizing a free coaching in the month of Januaruy,2014 at Janata Higher Secondary School, Hatsingimari.

Computer Training programme

In this financial year 2014-2015 , our N.G.O North East Zone Welfare Development Society conduct a free computer training programme to poor students in South Salmara Mankachar Sub-division for three months free computer training programme for specially for the students who belong from below poverty line, at Hatsingimari Junior College in 2014 with permission from the college principal. Here we saw that hundreds of student came and join with us in this free coaching.

Formation of Self Help Group and Training

This N.G.O North East Zone Welfare Development Society formed more than two hundred fifty groups of S.H.G in South Salmara Mankachar Sub-division, besides these this N.G.O also provide training to the SHG groups to make this group self reliant.

Nursery
